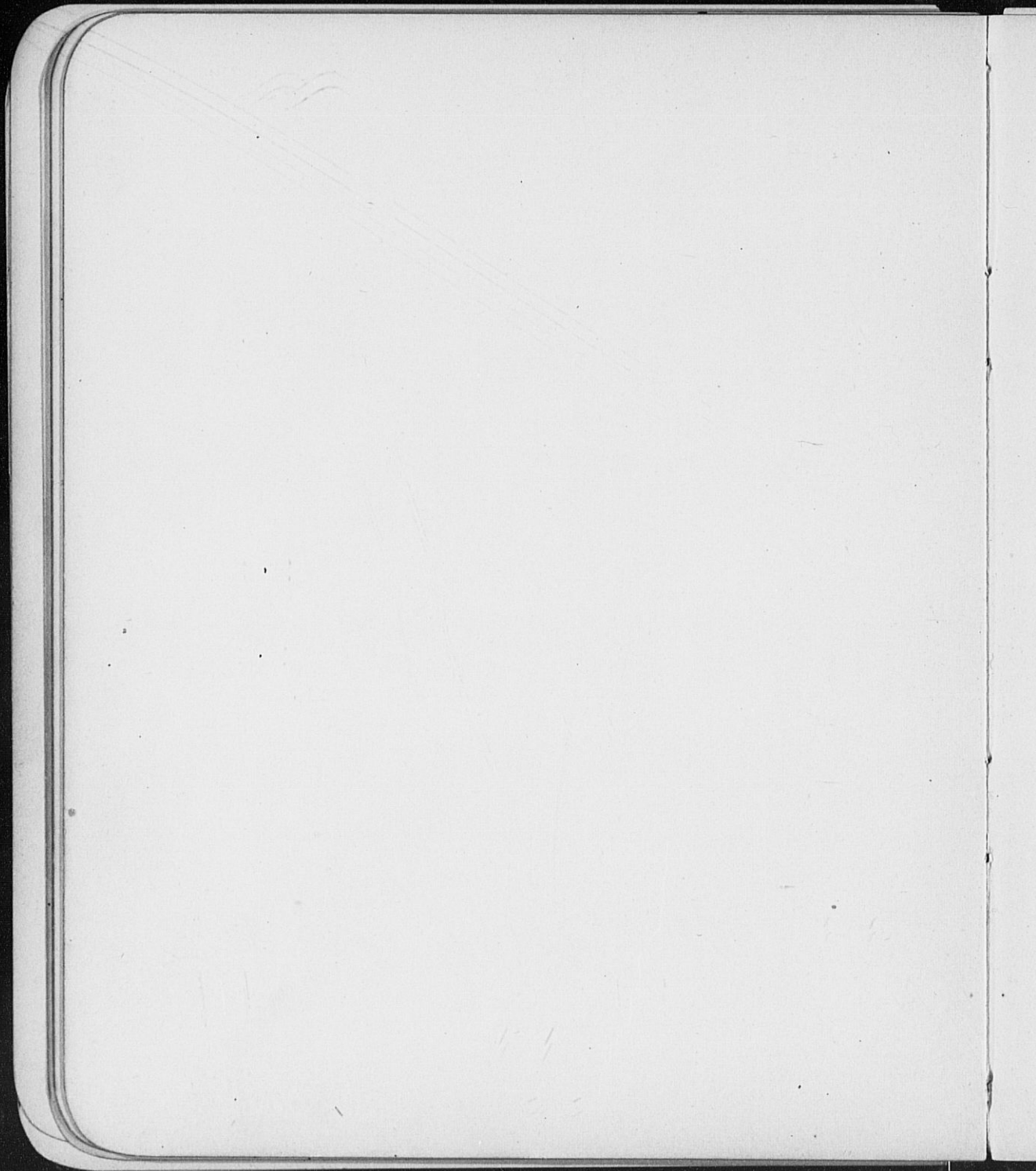


Dear Ina,

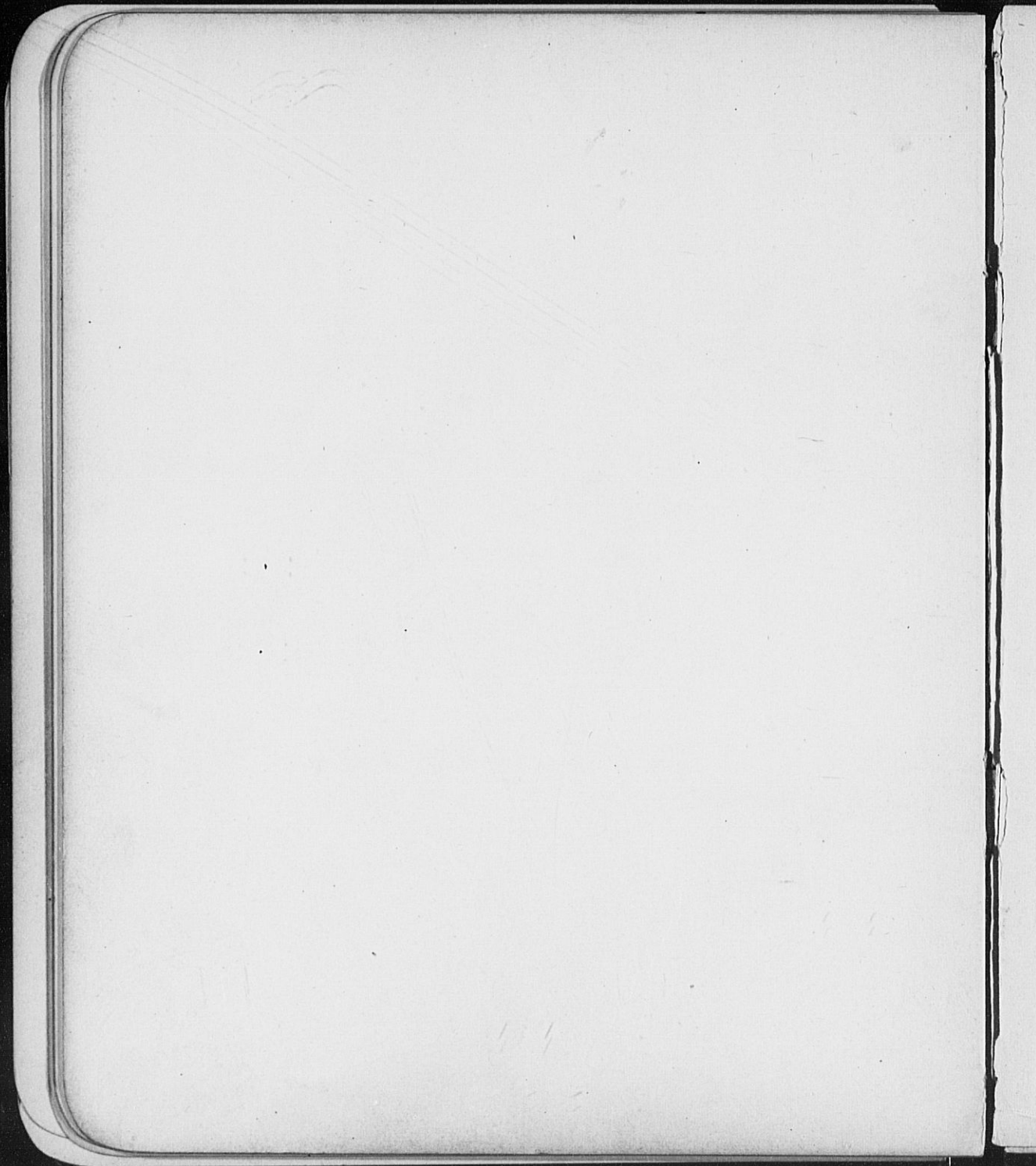
