- 100 lbs of Apples
 2.3 gallons of Water
 2.1 " " Cider?

- 2 pounds of salt.
 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " " Sugar.

Chilli Sauce

seasoned meat on one half and
fold the other over like a puff.

Ginger Snaps.

- 1 quart of Molasses.
 1½ gill " Water.
 1 oz of Ginger.
 4½ " " Soda.
 12 oz of Sard.
 12 " of Sugar.

Soft Ginger Bread

- 1 quart Molasses.
 1 pint Milk
 5 eggs.
 2 cups Butter
 3 Teaspoonfuls Soda
 3 Cream of Tartar.

Season to the taste and
 mix a little stiffer than
 pancake batter.

Try a light brown and serve hot.

Canning Lemons.

Peel the lemons slice and take the seeds out; then take half a pound of sugar to each pound of lemons. cook about 20 minutes and then can. They will keep a year or more and be very nice for lemonade, apple pie &c.

Cut the grains from one doz ears of boiled corn and mix them with one quart of lima beans that have been well boiled in salt and water and drained. Put all into a pan immediately and cover them in order to keep them hot.

Beat 2 eggs light and pour over the corn & beans with butter and pepper to suit the taste. Send to the table hot.
