

This Indenture Witnesseth,

THAT William Neal of Berkshire and State of Massachusetts hath put and placed, and doth hereby put and place his daughter, Sarah Neal under the care and direction of Alonzo Brown of Barncock in the County of Berkshire and State of Massachusetts, to be by him brought up, educated and instructed, according to the usages, principles and rules, of the Society of which the said Alonzo Brown is now a member; and to dwell with and faithfully serve the said Alonzo Brown, and his lawful commands every where and at all times readily obey, until the said William Neal is of lawful age, which will be on the eight day of July in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty seven, if said Sarah Neal should then be living. And the said William Neal doth hereby covenant with the said Alonzo Brown, and his legal representatives, in case of his decease, that he will not hereafter, either directly or indirectly, cause the said Sarah Neal to leave the service of the said Alonzo Brown or his legal representatives during her minority. Nevertheless, if the said minor shall at any time, during said term, become discontented, refractory or vicious, and the said Alonzo Brown shall wish to return the said minor to the said William Neal for either of said causes, the said William Neal agrees to take away said minor and make no demand whatever of the said Alonzo Brown or his legal representatives, on said minor's account.

AND the said Alonzo Brown agrees, on his part, to bring up and instruct, or cause to be brought up and instructed, the said Sarah Neal as aforesaid, and provide, or cause to be provided, good and sufficient food, clothing and lodging, and take proper care of said minor in sickness and health during the time said minor shall serve him the said Alonzo Brown, or his legal representatives; and at the expiration of said minor's minority, if the said minor shall reside with the said Alonzo Brown or his legal representatives, so long, and obey his, or their, lawful commands, the said Alonzo Brown or his legal representatives, will give to said Sarah Neal two suits of wearing apparel, one suitable for Lord's Day, and the other for working days, and new Bible
