presents do give grant bargain and sell unto  
him the said Thomas Law his heirs, executor, ad-  
ministrators and assigns all the Right, Title interest  
and Possession in and to a Lot of Land sold by  
Eliazar Deming & conveyed by deed to Amos  
Johnson and the said Thomas Law; being and  
containing twenty acres of Land then lying  
in Hancock County of Berkshire commonwe-  
alth Massachusetts and now lying now by  
the settlement of the Line between Common-  
wealth of Massachusetts and State of New York,  
in the State of New York. To have and to hold  
the above bargained premises with all the ap-  
purtenances therunto belonging or in any wise  
appertaining to him the said Thomas Law his  
heirs and assigns forever, and I the said Thomas  
Tanner do hereby engage myself, my my heirs  
or assigns and in behalf of the Amos Johnson  
deceased to warrant and defend the above bar-  
gained premises with all the Privileges  
therunto belonging against the lawful claim  
of any Person or Persons claiming by or under  
me as an administrator to the estate of Amos  
Johnson deceased In Witness whereof I have

recunto set my hand and seal this  
twelfth day of September, in the year of  
Our Lord One thousand seven hundred
