## Obituary—Hampton C. Bull.

DIED—At Lebanon Springs, N. Y., Tuesday, December 21st, Hampton Champlin Bull, aged 83 years.

Hampton Champlin Bull was born in Lebanon Springs, N. Y., September 16th, 1814, and with the exception of a few years residence in Detroit, Mich., he spent his life in the town of his birth. He had an exceptionally logical, strong, vigorous mind, and was educated for the law. His faculties were all unimpaired to the last. For many years he held the office of justice of the peace, at Lebanon Springs, and he was twice elected justice of sessions, which gave him his title of judge. In the discharge of his duties as justice of the peace his endeavor was always to help contending parties to settle their differences without a suit at law, if possible, and in many cases he succeeded. Mr. Bull wrote quite widely for the press, and was particularly happy in humorous articles. He was an interesting conversationalist, with a fine memory, extending back to his early youth. He had a vivid recollection of many stories of the Revolutionary war, told him by his two grandfathers, from their personal experiences, and he personally met the Marquis de LaFayette when he revisited this country during Jefferson's administration. Mr. Bull had been a member of Unity Lodge No. 9, F & A. M. for more than fifty years, and his interest never relaxed during his life. The beautiful Masonic service was used at his burial. His brother masons tenderly committed his body to the grave, and his spirit to God who gave it. Mr. Bull was widely known and greatly respected, his loss will be deeply felt in the community in which he lived. In 1838 Mr. Bull married Elizabeth Cornelia Cowles, daughter of John Cowles, of Adams, Jefferson Co., N. Y. In 1840 his wife died. Mr. Bull contracted a second marriage in 1843 with Frances Lodema De LaNo, daughter of Maj. Amos Wendell De LaNo, of Hancock, Mass. Mr. Bull is survived by his five children, Mrs. Charles E. Burfitt and John Bull of Pittsfield, Mass.; Miss Leila Bull of Osaka, Japan; Miss Clemence W. Bull of Lebanon Springs, N. Y.; and Luther B. Hampton of Philadelphia, Pa.
