My Government has ordered me to communicate to you that the King, my Gracious Sovereign, after the death of His Father, has reviewed and accepted with pleasure the Book, that you, by a letter dated the 29 Nov 1843, sent to His Majesty the late King of Sweden and Norway, and which Book bears the Title: A Holy Sacred and Divine Roll and Book sent forth by the Lord Gods of Heaven to the inhabitants of the earth.
