The party of the first part to have the use of the said mill to saw out his own, or any custom logs that are now, or may be put into the mill yard, and in consideration of such privelage shall load the said mill and appurtenances thereto on the Cars of the EERIE RAILROAD AT OQUAGO STATION ON OR BEFORE the 15th day of June 1899.
