The Words of Eternal Wisdom.

made known by the Angel of discernment

Monday evening May 2^d.

1842

Afternoon, previous to the above date, we attended meeting with the first Order at the holy Sanctuary; and the holy Angel of discernment appeared in the midst, and with a still small voice, proclaimed the words of Eternal Wisdom, through an instrument of mortality. When the holy angel had finished his word, he rose on his wings, which were as the sun, saying; "In union with the beloved Anointed of God, I will visit the second part of

"of this Church to morrow evening,"
"and whoso cometh with me, the
"same will reveal themselves at my
arrival.

At twenty minutes before seven,
P.M. the Angel of discernment
entered the Elders room saying; "I have
"come hither at the appointed time,
"and unto you will I reveal the words
"of Eternal Wisdom; and it is her will,
"in union with you that there be two
"witnesses present also."

Two instruments, one from the
right & one from the left were called
forth to witness the words of the Angel
which were as follows

Beloved Anointed, I have come forth
even from the Throne of Eternal Wisdom
who hath sent me to reveal her words,
and to make known her will unto
you.

You thus & thus did Holy Wisdom
say unto me; go quickly to my valley
even to the second part of my Church,
and choose an instrument who know-
eth nought concerning what you shall
speak. Therefore, beloved Anointed,
(said the Angel of discernment,) fear
not because of the gift, that I have
come to reveal through this instrument
even in the second part of this Church.
Marvel not, again I say, for this is the
instrument of my own choosing, &
Wisdom blesseth the work of my power.
(Then the Angel spoke to the witnessess

as follows.) Ye, who are recording instru-
ments, bow low your souls, and incline
a listening ear unto my words, that
ye may record them correctly. For so
shall they go forth to the holy Anointed.
Unto the beloved Anointed, will I now
reveal the will of Eternal Wisdom.

It is the will of Holy & Eternal
Wisdom, that there be no more public
meeting held at the holy Sanctuary,
for one year from this present time.
I am an Angel of discernment, &
power is given me to search the hearts
of the wicked. And truly they have
laid many plots against you; but
I know their evil designs.

Marvel not, beloved Anointed, at
my words for what holy Wisdom
 hath given unto me, will I reveal

unto you.

Your heavenly Parents, knowing the evil designs of the wicked, have bowed before the throne of Eternal Wisdom, crying incessantly for the protection of their children, in this beautiful Valley. And it is through their intercessions that this gift is granted, of which I now am the holy bearer. — Yea great is the tribulation of your heavenly Parents, who know in what way the filthy, depraved children of this world are laying out to visit you, anxiously waiting for the privilege.

Therefore, O beloved One, this gift is granted to you by Eternal Wisdom in condescension & great mercy,

Yea let her words be understood;
 There shall be no more publice
 meeting, for one year at least, and
 longer if it can be brought about;
 for this will defeat the evill doers of
 iniquity; & by no other means can
 their abominations be stayed from
 defiling this holy ground, & bringing
 tribulation upon the faithful.

Words of the Holy Angel of Eternal Truth.

Truth, truth, solemn truth, is that
 which my brother has spoken; I can
 witness to its truth, that it is the feel-
 ing of your Holy Holy Mother, & your
 blessed Mother Ann, that publice

meeting should be stopped, for the space of one year, or longer if it can be.

So beloved Anointed do see if there cannot be some way to stop it; if there can be no other way, publish it in their news papers, for that will be owned. Write it with your own hand, or cause it to be written by the hands of the wicked, and any of the Editors will put it in their papers. You may rely on my word.—

Words of the Holy Angel of Love.

Love, love, and peace; love is my mission, and I witness to the truth of what has been proclaimed in

your ears; for I was in the hearing of
Holy Holy Wisdom when she made
known her will.

And your blessed Mother Ann has
felt great tribulations about this thing;
she does not want that this ground
should again be stained by the feet of
the wicked, as it has been, seeing
it has been so thoroughly cleansed.

And I would that this be made
known to the beloved Elders at the
first order as soon as to morrow;
and as soon as the Ministry come
that it be made known to them:-
But beloved Elders you know
that you can govern such things
in their absence.— So may love
and peace echo & reecho through
this lovely Valley.

Words of Father William

I am thankful to witness to the truth of what the three Holy Angels have spoken.

conviction before, that lead them
there; they must have come under
a very different sense than people
in general do, in this day.

Circuses, Museums, Theatres and
Shows, and they can go there to
amuse themselves, and not come
to make sport of the true worship
and worshipers of God, and be
much better for them.

And as this place has been so nice-
ly cleared, we do not want it to
be defiled again by the wicked

And when the Ministry come, they
will feel full union with this gift
for I know their feelings.

So I should be glad to have all
that the Holy Angels have spoken,
correctly written, that the Ministry
may have a copy of it; and what
I have spoken too.
