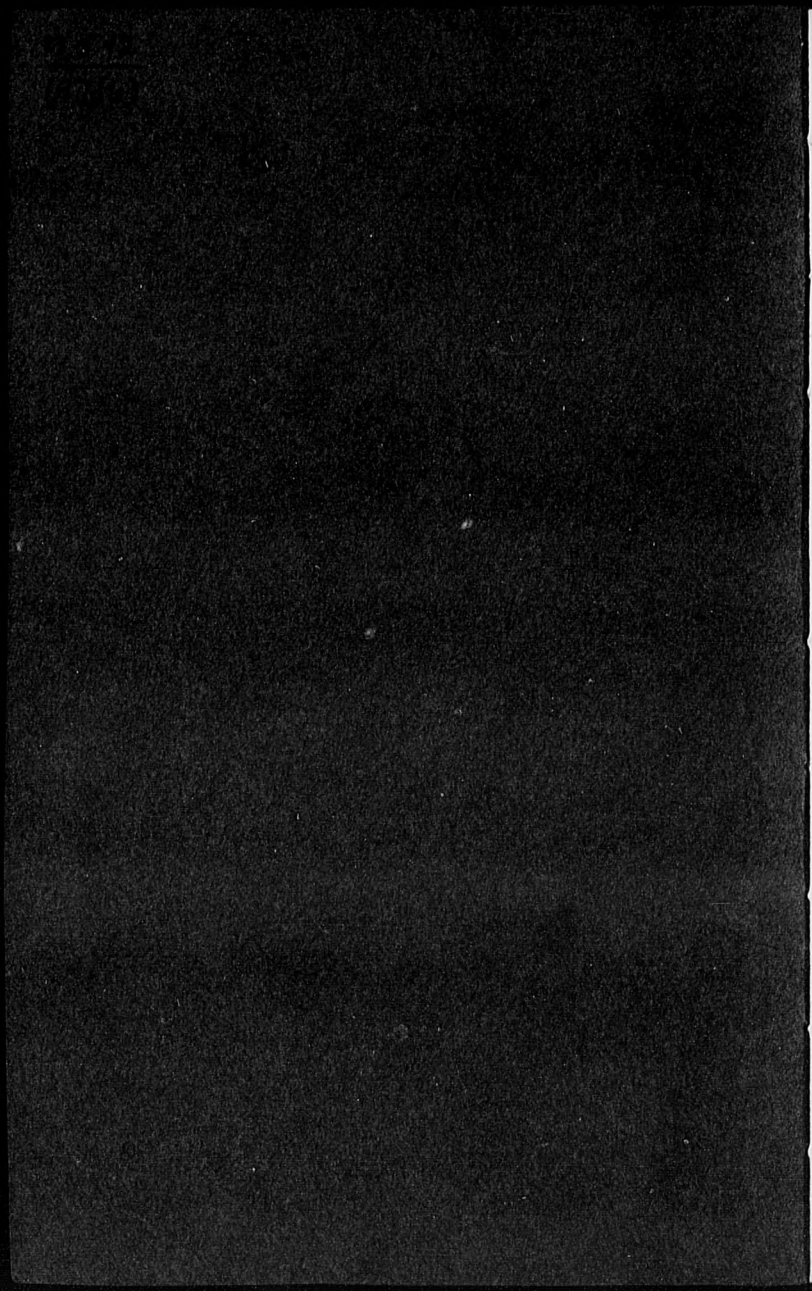

A Letter from the Savior to Elder  
Ebenezer, written by Inspiration at the  
South family, Wisdoms Valley May 21<sup>st</sup>.  
1842.

I, the Savior, will write a few words of comfort to thee, my dearly beloved little one; for thou art truly beautiful in my sight; and pleasing for thy Mother to look upon; for thou hast been a faithful laborer in the Vineyard of thy God.

Yea, thou hast merited the unbounded riches of Heaven, by thy faithfulness: yea, much has been the good counsel and instruction which thou hast been able to give the little flocks of my fold, from time to time: yea, and thy labors have been blessed & bleblessed,

O my faithful one! Yea, the blessings of  
 Heaven have been showered down upon  
 thee: and will continue to flow, while  
 thou dost remain on earth, and when  
 thy work is done, thou shalt dwell in a  
 peaceable mansion of rest; yea, thou  
 shalt have the reward of thy labors; for a  
 faithful laborer thou hast been.

Yea, a valiant warrior thou art against  
 evil: blessing, blessing be unto thee, O  
 thou little one: Yea, more than pen can  
 describe, are the riches laid up for thee.

And now I will tell thee that by thy  
 side is a little bright Angel, which will  
 remain there through time, to nourish  
 and strengthen thee on thy journey, &  
 on thy shoulder is a little white dove, of  
 pure love, and there he will sing love

and comfort. And on thy head is a  
 box of Stars, and a Cup of strength:  
 and in thy right hand have I, the  
 Savior, placed a beautiful Ball, and  
 on the outside of the Ball is a gold  
 cord; wound round; and in the Ball is  
 manna, and my love, for thee to eat.

These things are sent to thee, for a  
 comfort and consolation, to thee, my  
 little Son: for pure and holy art thou  
 in ~~my~~ <sup>the</sup> sight of thy God: And thou art  
 a pleasure to thy Mother.

In thy left hand is a basket of  
 Cherries and Strawberries, picked  
 fresh from Mother's garden, & placed  
 there by the little Angel that stays  
 by thy side.

In this letter was found a little

leaf from Holy Wisdom; And on it is written; O thou chosen & holy anointed little one of mine! wilt thou receive a little present from me? O yea, surely, you will say, yea, Mother, I will, and feel very thankful to you for it. Well, what shall I give thee, O thou little precious one?
