

ANGEL ALPHINE SACRAVENA.*



A Divine Communication from the holy and
glorious Angel, Alpine Sacrament,
being the closing Revelation and Confirmation
of all the Prophetic Testimonies and Reve-
lations of the ancient Prophets. Given by
inspiration, at the Holy Mount of God,
First Order, January 5th 1842.
Calvin Green, Instrument.

Introduction by the inspired Writer.

While writing to Reveler^{as} for t Prophet Da-
niel, nearly a yr ago, th beloved Prophet in-
formed me, th t glorious, holy Angel, who ap-
peared to him while on Earth, and who was
t Angel of t order of Proph^{ts}, and t Prince
of Prophecy, wd deliver a sacred message, as
t closing communication of these proph^{ic} writings.

After th, t holy Angel w^r revealed to me in
meeting, and told his name, and communicated t nature
of his Revel^r; but informed me th it wd be reser^{ved}
to close t proph^{ic} commun^{tions} wh ^{should} be called
to write in t pres^t work. And I recd no in-

pressions to write it until t Proph^t informed me
tt they had concluded their present Testimonies.

The spirit of th wonderful Angel then began
to press his command ^{star} upon my spirit, and to warn
me, by a mild sound of his heavenly trumpet,
th he shd call me to write it. But, feeling a
deep sense of my unworthiness, I tht myself
unfit to come near to such a holy being as to
receive a message fr him, and write it in the
genuine spirit of t gift. For this reason, my
feelings were, tt, if it cd be t will of God, I shd
desire th it might pass fr me; yet I was de-
termined to obey, if really required, at any sac ^{be} witness.

Therefore I labored and cried to God, almost
contin^g, to be prep^t to write in t spf of truth,
when^t called by t Ang. so to do. My labor of
soul were for several days, bef. I w finally
called upon to write. During th time I know
not th I ever bef felt such severe sufferings of
spf, and deep tribulⁿ of soul. I felt greatly
embarr^{sd} and sorely buff^r respecting my unfitness.

My guardian spirit then tol^e me tt this
mess^g fr t holy Ang wd be exceed^g precious;
and tt t advent^d of all good w^r stirring to hinder

me fr^t being t instru^t therf; and if I w prev,
by heark^t to h^e evil infl^{ce}, I shd ever fal
t loss therf. I then resisted t tempter, and
cried, Lord, thy will be done! but I prepare me
to do th^t wk in its purity; f I am unworthy.

Feeling a sense of t Angel's holy sp^t, made my
soul shrink at t undertaking.

In t even^t of t th^t inst. t^r they gave me no-
tice t he shd, t next day, req^r me to write all
t he shd inspire into my soul; f it must no
longer b delayed. The following night, in a dream,
or rather a night vision, I saw, upon a table,
an open bk in manuscript, top^r with an ink-
stand and pen. I w then direct^r to transcribe
t writing fr t book; f it w t communication
fr t holy Angel.

After passing t night in much trib^r, I labord t
next morn with all my feelings to b prepared.

The Ang then infor^r me tt t cause of my severe
sufferings and tribulations w^t to prep^r me to b his
inst; & which I needed to be greatly purified. &
tt th^t sufferings had more^{sd} and wo increase, to show
me, tt, however trying, I cd not get by doing th^t
work; & truly it said as tho' it wo early or quite late my
life, if I did not do it.

Therefore I resigned myself in obedience; & the Angel then spake peace to my troubled soul. I then knelt down, and bowed to the floor, & was impressed with such a gift of prayer as I scarcely ever felt bef. And I pray'd earnestly th I might h an undeniable evidence of my call to this work. At th time, my soul beheld t Ang, most beautiful & lovely, in a heavenly cloud of pure white & clear brightness. My right hand & arm w^t then arrested fr under my power, stretch'd out & powerfully shaking, & there appear'd bef me, extended over t table, t resemblance of a large sh^t of transparent paper, with unknown characters upon it, and t Angel's name written in letters of shining gold; & there w^t appear ^{ce} of a beaut white pen given me, and I w^t bid to write. And, when I rose to write, I recov^t the power of my hand & arm, wh I d^d not do bef.

My spt felt as tho it w^t set on fire, & t Ang pour'd t wds into my soul as fast as my hand could write them. And here follows the communication:-

Chapt. I.

5

The Aug reveals his own order - the true intention of Prophecy - the probationary trial of Angels, of all spts, and souls of men - and shows t necessity for th probationary trial.

1. Thus saith t holy Aug of Proph^c Light:
Arise, thou mortal dust; hearken, & in deep humility, & in t solemn fear of thy God, write thon t sacred testimony of revelation, of wh I h given thee notice, & wh I sh now speak clearly in thy soul, as a closing Witness & confirmation of all t testim^c, revl^c, & proph^c, wh thou hast been called to write in th present holy & glorious visitation.

2. Th day of visit^m hath truly been disting^d above all otrs, by t shining forth of eternal bright^s & Divine gifts, wh h been poured out with measure, fr t holy & etern^c Heavens upon t chos^m child^m of Zion.

3. I am a most holy Aug fr t etern^c Heaven of Heavens. My name is Alpine Sacrament, t Prince of Proph^c. My dwelt w never on earth in a tab^m of clay. I never dwelt in any of t shades of death or darkness.

4. But by my eternal Parents w^t I b^r forth;
yea, long ages of ages bef. th cre^t in wh ye dwell
w^t began; & in their eternal light & glory h^t I ever
dwelt. My mansion is in t elem^t of t attribute of
eter light; f^t I b^r ever obeg, with deli^t, t will
of my Eterl Parents, & h^t been faith^t to what they re-
quired of me.

5. Yea, I stood firm unshaken in their pure
light, at t time of t 1st trial of t Angels in the
spir^l world, when t fierce & mighty prince^s powers
of etern dark^l shook all things th cd b^r shakken,
& made many of t powers of t heavens to tremble,
bef. he & his power were overcome & driven back.

6. Th mighty strok^{le} of t powers & o^sts of d^kneff
w^t designed & attempted for t purp^e of hindering t
increas^t & creative wks of t Alm^t Parents. But
their power, majes^t, & glory, w^t finally magn^t thereby.
For these dk & mighty powers w^t overthrown expelle^d,
& shut out, by eternal barriers.

7. Therefor. the many of t Angels & o^sts, ~~w^t stood~~
~~faithful in their trial, increas^t in power & glory, and~~
~~w^t thus prep^t to b^r w^t with their Eterl Parents,~~
which h^t been brought forth to b^r agents & oking
powers in t creative wks & orders of t heavens &

earth, wht Cre^t h purpose to form & set in
order, & overcome, & fell. Yet t Alm^t purposes
of Powr & Wisdom w not in t least derang thereby.

8. For all t Angels & spts th stood faithful
in their trial, increas^d in powr & glory, & w thus
prep^d to b wks with their Eter^t Parents, in t
wk of form & set^d in order to crea^m of t heavens
& earth, because they h been tried, & proved faithf^l

Thsfr t Crea^t found them trusty agents,
to whom t order & estab^t of all things my b safely
committed.

9. Bef th gt strugle, t spts & powers of d^{rk}
advanc^e much furth in t eternal wld than at
t pre^t time; & they h been driven b^e many stages,
and t Alm^t hath placed ster barriers at ea stage,
wh they cannot pass. Therefore all within these
barr^{rs} r^e ever secure. But, long bef th barr^{rs}
were found, Satan, thro^t influence of t power of
evil, fell fr his original state, & became t prince
of those rebel spts whom he employs to tempt
creat^r in a state of probation.

10. The wks wh h flowed fr t Eter^t Source of
creative Powr & Wiss, are infinite & incompre^ble
in extent, by any crea^r being. I h seen myriad

8. If wds crea^r, & replenished with intel^t & animate
beings, both bef & since t creation of th wld in wh
ye dwell. And many there & th I know, who &
yet bals & elements of darkness; inwh^t only by t
dk & evil monsters, as t dk & gt deep of this
wld once was. And know ye tt t creating wls
of creative power will pro^f this infinite ages.

11. The princ^e of dk & t power of evil can not
be made manifest as t oppo^{ts} of t principle of
Divine light & t eter^t power of good, until good &
light percdt; then t elem^t of dkss & evil w^{ll} man-
ifested as t eter^t oppo^{ts} of goodness & light.

12. The gt Source of eter^t good & light extends
thru & beyond all cre^r things; & th^r can never b^e seen
or comprehended, as a real Being, by any creature;
but c only b^e seen & known by t elem^t princ^e & spea-
tions, wh flow fr th infinite Source. But t Ete^t
Parents can be truly seen & known in proportion
to t purity of t creature.

13. Neither c any crea^r see and compr^{re}, as a
being, the eternal oppo^{ts}, t source & power of evil &
spiritual dks. This also c only b^e seen & known
by t elem^t princ^e & spea^r wh proceed therefrom.

14. This power, tho excdly gt, is not infinite.

The power of good is great, and is, & always has been,⁹
beyond & above it. But the power of evil extends thro'
all things where the nature of Divine light & goodness
is not formed; by wh alone the power of evil can
be driven back, & barrⁱⁿ found wh it c^t pass. No
creat^d being, by his own power, cd ever do this.

15. The mighty archangel Lucifer, (who, after his
fall, w^r calls Satan, i.e. t adversary) w^r t ring leader
of t rebellion in t sp^l wld, & caused t fall of
multitudes of angels & sp^{ts}; but he w^r not t first
agent in t element of evil, nor t King in etern^l dk^{ss}.
This w^r Aphollion, or t Destroyer, so called because
he has ever been a destroyer among t works of God
"from t beginning."

16. But being influenced by those principles of evil,
& receiv^d & foll^d them, Lucifer w^r, in t end, born into
their very nature, & became identif^d with t first
gt agent of t power of evil, & thus became t prince
of t tempting sp^{ts}, which tempt beings in a proba-
tionary state. In, by his former experience in the
heavens, he w^r more able to do than any other sp^l of
evil. But the power of evil is limited by t All^g.

17. Th^ro^r, after t foremen mighty strug^{le}, t way
w^r prep^d f^r t creation to be bro^{ut} forth in all its

10 progressive degrees of order. Neverth^o, similar in
string will be made by t infernal prince
& power of dark^{ss} agst every increas^g degree of t wks
of t Alm^r, until all t orders of God's eterl Kingdom
are completed.

18. No power of dths ad ever stand before any other
light, wh w given by t Alm^r, to dwell in me, when I
w placed in my eterl order. Threfore, fr. t begin^g
of t preparⁿ for t visible creative wks of God, my
office hath ever been to prophesy by his Divine Spirit;
and thereby, ^{to} make known to all^l beings, to whom t time
is come, t true nature & order of t true wks of God,
in successive degrees & times, as far as it is necessary,
in t order of his own appointment.

19. These proph^{es} w necess^y, to prepare those
whom t wk shall concern, to b in readiness to rec^e
it when it shd come; & to b wks with it, ac-
cording to what wd be required of them.

20. And it w also necess^y for these proph^{es} to be
recorded in heaven & earth, (as far as t nature of t wk
on earth did require), tt they may stand as a clear
evidence to all rational beings, in t time of their ful-
fill^t, tt they cd h proceeded fr no other source than t
Fountain of all light & true knowledge; therefore

that t work must proceed from Almighty
Power and Wisdom.

11

21. Thus t faith of all beings will be righteously
& justly tried, and their obedience proved, by t evi-
dence wh is adapted to their rational understand;
that t God of all may b thereby manifest, to all his
intell t creat'rs, in his light, power, wisdom, majesty,
and all his perfections, and every creature left
with any ground of excuse.

22. Th is t true end & design of all t proph'cs
wh h ever been given fr t beginning, or ever will
be given to t end of time. I am t Prince of this
order of Prophetic Light. I w one of the
seven eldest & brightest among t morning stars
& sons of God who sang together, and shouted for joy
when t Alb' Cov' laid t found ns of t earth.

23. For t wch h long bef been rev'd unto me, by
t Divine Spt of Light, and by me had been prophes'd
to th morning stars & sons of God. And they had
long anxiously waited fr t wch to take place, thfr
they knew it when it began, after their gt trial;
and thus they rejoiced with joy unspeakable.

24. By t coun' of my Eter Father, I moved
with his etern light, left t Divine Spt of Eternal

12. Mother Wisdom, when She moved & brooded upon
the face of t waters, or chaos, of t st deep, until
the creaⁿ w^t br^t forth & set in order in all its principles
and elements.

25. Yea, & all t holy Angels & Spirits, who proved
faith^t to their trust when tried, h^e ever rejoiced with
st joy, in every incre^s degree of t works of their
Parents. And every such deg. brings increas^s honor,
glory, & happiness to them.

26. For they all r, & ever will be workers together,
accord^t to their respec^{ve} orders, in every degree of t
works of God, for ever & ever. And to them is com^{to}
t govern & administer of all t principles & elem^{ts}, in
all t orders of t heavens and earth.

27. And th high, glorious, & holy charge they fulfil
in t most exact & willing obedience to t will of their
Hon^r Parents, & in t most perfect subordⁿ to the
orders wh^e r respectively placed bef them. Here
is t founderⁿ of all true order & government in the
eternal order of t Angels & Spirits of God.

28. These, therefore, c never administer goodness
in any other way; nor c God ever be truly known in
any other line, than thro^t medium of t orders of his
own appoint. And t Angels have no delight os

gt as to labor in their own order, in t. wh, & accord^g ¹³
to t will of their heavenly Parents.

24. But know, all ye childⁿ of earth, tht
childⁿ of t sp^t wld, yea, all t Angels in heeven,
had to pass thro a state of probat^y trial, between
t inclinations of their own independ^t or self life,
& subjecⁿ to t will of God, as manifes^t in t ord^r of them.

25. This trial they all had to pass thro, & prove
themselves bdt & faithfl in their first estate,
bef their Cre^r wld take them as his Messen^r &
Agents to do all his wks, & administer to, and
direct all t crea^r of his wld. If th is their call
and wh, ex accord^g to t oder of his creation.

26. Therfor they w^r all first creat^r in a state
below their true oder; & their real oder wpl before
them, as an obj^c of hope, wh they might gain by ob^c
& self-sacrifice. And when they h proved thems^w
faith^c to t perf^t will of God in tt state, then
they rose by t Eter^r Powr into a far higher state,
even into t light of their Creator.

27. Here their Eter^r Parents b prep^r man-
dons of play f them, in t flowings of their Div^e
love, & in dep^r accord^g to their oder. Then, & not
bef, did they find their prop^r oder, as Mess^r

14 { of His light, power, & holiness, and Agents of
all t wks of Eterl Power & Wisdom.

33. Yet all t Angels & spts of God do, & f
ever will, increase with t inc^{re} & expansion of
Gods wks. And, by th^t labors therein, they & con-
tinually adding to th^t glory, new gems, new flowers
of most exquisite beauty, & new stars of such ef-
fulgent brightness & glory as we more & conceive fr
while dwel in an earthly state. And know ye,
th^t in like manner sh^t it b with all t spts of
mort^{ls} who prove faithf^l in their trial.

34. Thus saith t mighty & glo^s Ang of Prop
Light, ye mort^{ls} think it strange, because of yr
sore trials, wh^t ye c^t avoid, & many times wond^r
what they mean. But unto you I say, It is
impos^t th^t any crea^l being sh^t rec^e any rew^r,
any honor or glory of th^t own, or in them^s, without
th^t own labor & earnings.

35. All crea^l spts ever h^t been, & ever mst
b^r, placed in a state below the prop^r order of th^t
crea^l, th^t they may gain th^t final ord, & t rew^r of
faithful^s by th^t own labor b^r they cⁱnt^r th^t birthright.

36. And t eleut^y life of th^t ord in wh^t they &
first crea^l, as a state of prob^r, must have an

attractive infl^{ce}, & a bind power, upon th^t self life,¹⁵
& this they must sac^e b^fef they c^rise to a higher order.
But t higher life of t ord f wh they r created, hath also
its strong, attract^{ve} powers upon t light of th^t ration^l
understanding.

37. Here is th^t trial. Thos t lower attractive
power, t spt of dk^r, fr t eter shades of evil, c h
access to, & tempt them with its counter^{ft}, alluring,
& delus^{ce} charms. And, if they hearkⁿ to th spt, they
will follow th^r own inclina^s, wh will appear to them
as t very ess^e of th^t own life; & foll^g these, they will
fall under t power of t tempt² spt, & will b^e led into
t shades of dk^r, fr whence th spt came.

38. But those souls & spts th obey, & wk with t
light, wh always shines fr above, to all beings in
a st of real probation, will, by deg^r, rise to th st fr
whence t light cometh, wh h attract^p them to obed^{ce},
& by its power strength^p them to endure th^t trials. Thus
they will rec^e evr^t honor & rew^d f th^t own labors.

39. And th hon^r & rew^d will always b^e gt in pro-
por^t to the lab^r, suff^{ce}, & trials, wh h been need^{ce}
to obtain t prize.

40. But beware, O ye child^r, yea, let every soul
beware, th ye charge not upon t Div^e Spt of Good^r

16 those trials wh^e ye bring upon yourselves, by yr own misdeeds. Th^e is a sin of ingratitude, & wh^e you will surely be called to account.

41. For such trials & scourge^r f^r yr own disobe^c; & even these r preparⁱⁿ f^r mercy to those who h^e not sinned away th^t day of probation.

42. All t^e dealings of G^od toward his crea^{re} r perfectly just, & f^r the best good of all who r rightly exercised therby. Th^e is sac^t truth, & every crea^{re} will yet know it.

43. Thus saith t^e holy Aug: Let no honest souls faint bcc of t^e severity of th^t trials & suff^{rs}, f^r my angels of light watch over all souls who h^e not lost th^t final call. And these angels well know t^e path wh^e is best f^r every crea^{re}, & w^t kind of trials will b^e proper to prep^e ea & every soul f^r his final ord in t^e eter^l wo.

44. Th^t ye hearken, I hearken to th^t silent voice, when they speak unto yr souls. Ye^t hear, murmur not; but obey, & follow th^t light; & it sh^e ever be well with you. Verily, if ye do th^t, ye sh^e lose no fit of t^e honor, glory, & happin^r th^t ye r cap^{le} f^r receiving.

45. For I say unto you, t^t t^e beaut^r mansions, t^e de-lightful bourns of t^e Par^e of G^o. t^e delic^r fruits, & streams of living waters; & all t^e glorious appear^{es}, & delightsome, pleas^r, & happy feelings, wh^e sh^e b^e seen & pos^{ss} by evry

soul, accdg^t to its creerⁿ, who faithfully endures t purify 14.
trials of t regnⁿ; sh fully satisfy all th^t feelings, &
exceed, by manifold, all th^t ye r capable of desiring
while in a mortal state.

46. So fear not, all ye sincere souls; but go man-
fully thro all yr trials; & all th^t ye will evr endure
in th life will yet app^t but as a drop of t ocean,
compr^e with t immor^l glory wh^t ye sh find in yr
heavly & etern home. Let this suffice concer
th matter; & t soul tt will not b satisfied with this,
would not be with more.

Chap. II.

The Ministratiⁿ of t Angels of Prophetic Light, &
t necessity therof declared. The union of t
Angels of Light, & those of Perf^t Wk revealed, &c.

In t Proph^c order, there r many angels of pure light
adapted to every st; & th^t call^t & wk is to go bef, &
prep^e t way, by dispersing proph^c light to souls and
spots in every deg. of t wk of G^d. And th^t h ever
been th^t call^t & wk fr t begin^g, & ever will b to end^g ages.

2. Therefor, know ye of certainty, tt there never is a

18. *vatl* being br't into t' wld whs is not noticed by some
of th' angels. And they dispense rays of th' proph'c
light to all souls, accdg to th' order & st. For all
light wh shows t' future conseq'ces & effect of any
moral tht, wd, or deed, is proph'c light, & is dispensed
by t' angels of t' order of prophetic light, whs r sent
forth by any directions.

3. It is on th' prd, tt t' testimony of Jesus is pres-
eminently t' spt of proph'cy. For th' spt foretells
t' view of all t' wks of souls & spths, in a higher deg
than any other spt ever did. These ~~angels~~ of my ord
ever delight in foreshowing t' wk of God to souls, & in
light & sptl lamp in them, tt they an thry see th' duty.

4. And, after they h' shown t' wk, accdg to its ord &
deg, then, in t' proper time appst of G., t' angels of t' true
ord of God's wk follow; & they labor & wk accdg to
t' pattern wh h' been shown by t' angels of light, &
wh is plainly written on shls of st., on all things &
beings tt r to b t subj^{to} of t' wk wh is to b wrought.

5. And t' time of th' wk is clearly mark'd on pillars
of ord, wh r placed in t' deg of t' proper ord & time of t'
progres^{we} growth of t' creaⁿ of G. And, when t' angels
of perfect wk come to that deg, they plainly see and
know t' nature, ord, & time thereof.

6. That's th angels of llt & revla, & t angels ¹⁹
of God's perf^t wk, always corresp & agree tog^t. But no
other sps c read t wrtgs of t former, nor kn t true
natur^d ord of t wks of t latter, any faster than they
& revealed by t angels of th respective orders.

7. For th cause said I to mytly beloved Prop^t Dani^l,
"There is none th holdeth with me in th things, but min
chall, yr Prince". For Michael is t Prince of t auxd^c
orders of perf^t wks, in t likeness of G^D, in th^r order;
as I am of t orders of proph^c light & revlu. Therf^r, in
all things, we & our respec^c orders, hold & operate tog^t,
in our proper times & labors, app^r by our Al^l Parents.

8. For th reason, sa I, "At th time sh Michael stand
up, t gt Prince who standeth f t chil^m of thy people; &
there sh b a time of trouble such as never w since there
w a nation, even to th same time. And at th time thy people
sh b del^d, every one th sh b found written in t Book."

9. For, until t angels of my ord disp^c th llt to souls,
they c never rec^e any degree of perf^t wk. They c rec^e t
sp^t of holiness; because, until they rec^e proph^c light,
by wh they are enabled to see t consequences of th^r deeds
upon th^r immort^l welfare, they c sense no motive f t cross
wh t sp^t of hol^{nes} requires, & its wks will bring.

10. Therf^r, until th event takes pl, they will be

held wholly by t instincts & propensities ^{is} of nature. But, when th lbt is given them, they c then rec^et convicting operations of t Angels of Holiness, th always follow t lbt. And thus they r prep^r to hear t sound of the trumpets of t Angels of Reformation; by wh they will be progress^g prep^r to hear t loud calls of t Angels & heralds of t Everlasting Gospel.

11. And no soul c ever b called & gath^r into t Room of Xt, without t operations of these four orders of angels. And t last two orders r, in a special manner, t powerful hosts of t gt Prince, Mic^c, in t twofold ord of his mani-
festation; ie. first in mat^e, & then in grace. The former being t wk of t Father; the latter, that of t Son. But all t per^u & wks of t orders of t Angels flow fr t Eternal Par^{re}, thro t seven Spts of God.

12. As Mic^c always stood f, & in t perf^t ord of G^d; so he & his angels always wkd accdg to th orders, in its present deg; thrfr he also^w stood f God's cov^t people; because they more noly repres^r t perf^t ord than any other people.

13. The time of trouble, foretold by me, first began in t first app^r of t S of G^d, for whose true ord & perf^t wk Mic^c & all his angels lab^r & fought, with all th' favor, agst t prince & powers of dhs: for th w^t beginning of t separation between t old creen & t new.

14. That it w^s by t speeⁿ of the ministrⁿ of th an-
gelic ord, th t times of trouble & terrible judg^ts thro-
out t wld, foll^P t persec^m of J. C. & his foll^{ers}, and re-
jec^m of his Gospel, accdg to t per^t ord of th day. But t
ultimate fulfilment of th things will b^e in th Dispensⁿ
of his second app^e with t holy Bride.

15. Th is t glorious, holy Dispⁿ of Divine Provid^e
and grace of G^D, wh began at t sounding of t seventh
trumpet, & is proceed^P, & will never^{ce}, until t true order
of all things is estab^P both in t heavens & earth, accdg
to t perf^t likeness of G^D in th^r nature & degree.

16. I am t glorious Angel of Light, who app^e to t
holy Proph^t Dan, by t river. At th time, I shewd unto
him many things, wh w^s noted in t SS of truth. For,
in all t wks of G^D, t true ord & patt^r is first shown;
then, in t true ord of time, t perf^t wk follows. There-
fore Mic, t^e t^e Pr of t ord of perf^t wk, held with me in all th things.

17. It w^s thro t medium of t holy angels of my order,
th all t ancient Prop^t w^s inspired; yea, thro them I guided
& directed all th^r prop^c gifts. For tho my angels r often
invisible & silent mess^y; yet, with t^t speeⁿ & pro-
phetic lkt, no soul's heart voice of any Div. Spt th^r spkst them.

18. All t wks wh G^D will ever do, both in heaven and
earth, to t full estab^t of his eter^l Kingdom, or first written

in t' etern' records of these Scriptures of truth; & nothing therein written shall ever fail.

19. Ther' t' Eter' Powr & West, in their own time, open t' pg to b reveal'd to t' holy Angels & Proph^t. Then, by my direcⁿ, they show t' things contr^t therein to chosen instr^t, in both t' spiritual & nat^rl wld.

20. And, when t' time is fully come f th' things to take pl, t' Angels of Perf^t Order & sent forth, under t' di-rectⁿ of t' powerful Archangel, Mic^l; & they wk accdg to t' pattern wh^t been shown by Divine light.

21. In t' first visitaⁿ of t' powers & hosts of Heaven, wh^t been going on f about four yrs past, t' etern' records of th' holy S.^t of truth h^t been reveal'd by t' manifest^s f yr eternal, yr holy, & yr heavenly Parents, & t' holy Angels & Proph^t, in a far gtr deg, & more wonderful manner, than evr w^t done bef, since th' creaⁿ began.

22. Ther' Mic^l, & his mighty hosts of angels, h^t come forth, & r^ewaging war agst t' 1st adversary and all his powers of this. Th' war w^t never cease, until they're deft, & driven out of evry power or hold in t' heavenly st. And t' hosts of Mic^l w^t follows th' d^r shps & powers, & overthrow th' high towers, pull down th' strong holds, & demolish th' high places throughout all t' world.

23. Then, as fast as t' way is thus prep^t, they will

23

build up & estab^lt perf^t order of t new heavens & new earth, wherein t dk spts & powers sh l no habt, nor places of strength. These angels w also build up a perf^t st of t ord of nature in t nat^l wld, in degs of a time, until t days throf^r or fulfilled. Then sh t nat^l order and state of the world pass away.

24. The manifest["] of t pres^t day of visita["], both of light & perf^t wk, h been & will b givn in and among t Israel of G^D, than t Eter^l Spt ever bsp dispense^d to t chln of men. And t same proph^t chln, & t same word wk of Mic^l w follow in t wld, after t visible displays throf^r & more closed & withdrawn fr Zion.

25. I say t same chln & wk w follow, both in the provd^l & spth orders in t wld; & w progress^l operate, accdg to th^t st, & what is reg^d of them, to prepare t way of t nat^l order, wht Crea^r is abt to establish, in his times, among all nations and people.

26. But th displays, in a spec^l manner, w prepare & t wk of t new crea^r, wh w grow & increase until its fair branches sh spr^d throughout all t earth, & all nations shall see & acknowl^g t power & glory of him; & they sh knw it is t only habta["] of t holy God of salvation.

27. Thsfr t same jng^l, & similar times of trouble, sh follow dissob^e to t true & perf^t order of G^D; & espec^l

24 & reject t' Gosp'l, & persecut' wth' th' off, & t' faithf'l
childr' of t' holy Parenage, wh' foll' th' things in Christ's
first app', but with add'l severity & power, until the
real trouble upon all flesh sh' exceed t' trouble, horr'ry,
and dross of those times.

28. But, in t' midst of th' times, "sh' thy people b' del'd."
i.e. t' sp'tl for, every one, th' by faithf'l obed'ce in foll'
t' Lamb of God & holy Bride, sh' b' found wthin in t'
Book of t' Eternal Records of Life.

29. These sh' all b' del'd by t' power & perf'c' wth' of Mic
& his angels; while Satan, & his d'k hosts, wh' w' b' by them
cast out of t' heavenly inherit'ce, w' come down & pour out
his wrath upon t' inhabit'ls of t' earth, & cause them, in
th' rage, to bite & destroy ea other; & thro them he w' perfec'
t' woman (t' Moth' of t' new creation) in her righteous seed.

30. But t' powers of t' earth w' cont'ue to open & divide, &
thus w' swallow up, in th' own bowls, t' sev'lt' flood of fury
& rage, so tt they c never destro' t' faith' of t' earth. These
things w' operate in degrees, one after another, until t' known.
It's w' b' perfec't in its ord' power, & glory, in both t' neth' & sp'tl world.

31. For th' purp'ct souls who h' slept in t' dust, (i.e. th'
fallen nature wh' is t' food of t' sev'lt') & gone into t' wld
of sp'its, sh' hear t' Gosp'l trumpet, & awake; yea, they sh'
hear t' sound of t' Gosp'l, & those who obey it sh' come

forth to ever^l life; & those who doo, sh come forth to
"shame & everlasting contempt." 25

32. For every soul th ever w^{re} crea^d, sh h^{ave} an offer of
the same self-decaying Gosp^l th y^e h, & must bear t
same cross, accdg to th^t order, unto t death of th^t own
life, whether they be in th^t wo^d, or in th^t wh is to come.

33. Otherwise they never c^o b red^d fr^t t power of Hess,
& rise in eternal glory, thro' endless ages. Tho' they may
be saved as by fire; but th^t w^{re} b manifld more terrible;
& yet, even in th^t case, they w^{re} et^{er} lose t glory of th^t birthright.

34. Know ye, for certainty, (let blind guides teach as
they may,) th^t soul is t subjt of t resurrecⁿ of life; the
natural body will never have any part therein.

Chap. III.

The Cause of Prophetic Revelations in t present day; -

The necessity of the Visitation of the Heavenly
Parents, &c.

And now, saith t Ang, I w show t true cause why
many prophesies & revel, "even of t prop^d books of G^od,
in t wo^d, h^{ave} been manifes^d to t chilⁿ of Liow; in this
t visitation, when but few had ever bef been res^d to them.

3. In t first open^d of t Gosp^l, & in t time of laying

the foundation & building of Zion, the Believers had to come out of the world, & break off from all the ^{old} ~~old~~ institutions & systems thereof. It was then necessary that they should improve all their time, strength, & talents, to gain & establish a new order of all things both spiritual & temporal, separate and wholly distinct from all that was upon earth.

3. For the heavenly Jerusalem is not yet appear'd on earth, nor was a stone of it formerly of Zion laid in the true order of the new creation. Wherefore it could not be known as the Zion & Jerusalem, for whence it had been promised that the Law & Word of the Lord should go forth to the children of men.

4. Hence, in the labor of laying the foundation of Zion, build & the true spiritual temple therein, & raise her walls & towers of strength, the general did all that they could do.

5. They had not strength to labor of prophecies ^{for} revelations of but very little that did not concern ^{for} the providential works of God in the world, their present duty; nor had they time to rec'd & commit them to writing. Now there is a body, as now, of such as have experienced a deep travail, to bear for any in such a labor.

6. Therefor, is not the time a labor been wholly turned to the Inner Court, Zion could never have been built, & her word established, so that the Word & Law of God could go forth thence to the inhabitants of the earth.

7. And during t time of t sec^d open^d, t labor of
gather souls, & estab^d new branches of t Kingdom of Zion,
tgo^t with t estab^d of t orders of ingather^d of souls, wh^t
r as her suburbs; & also t labor of publish^d a written
testimony, wh^t, sooner or later, w^t carry t sound
throu^t to the ends of t earth; & wh^t is t beginning of
t going forth of t Law fr^t Zion, to any gt extent;

8. The labor of all th things w^t all. It cd b^t suot^d in
th two travals of Believers. But, after t order of Zion
w^t estab^d throu^t all t faml^s of Israel, & many new
branches w^t raised up in t same ord, far & wide, then the
dk spks of t wld, & evil angels fr^t t shades of d^ress,
in many curring ways, & by many craftful devices,
made war upon Israel.

9. Th spks of d^ress, few^d by traitors, & t inexpect^e
of t rising gener^t, gained such ascendancy in all t
branches of Isr, tt nothing short of t sec^d many^m
of t same Heavenly Parents, this whom t founded^w
w^t laid, & Zion w^t built & her no first est, cd save her.

10. Nay, nothing short of th sec^d revol^m in spk and
irresistible power, cd save Zion fr^t being overcome,
& falling into t hands of her enemies & apost^t & dead
rebel chil^t. But, by t mighty w^t, t enemies h^t
been defeat^d & driven b^r into t wld. The traitors

within her walls h^e been cast out; & her broken walls h^e been repair^e stronger than ever.

11. Ther^r, to prevent t enemy fr^t ret^r, & again obtain power, & estab^t his strong holds in Isr^l, it w^e neces^r to pursue him on his own ground, thereby lay open his hiding places, pull^d down his strong holds of power, & overturn^r his high towers of strength, by t law & power of t Word of Alm^r God.

12. This w^e done, th t chilⁿ of Lion might see t abomination of t dwellings, & t weakin^s of th habbⁿs of t enemy, & might kn^t destruction th t God of all power h^e purpos^r to bring upon him & all his subj^ts; th they might no more seek a pt in his kdom, nor take shelter und^r th power wh must so surely fall, & his kdom in t wld come to nought.

13. Th w^e neces^r, th all t chilⁿ of Isr^l might trust in Lion, wh is now built up, & reestab^r in everlast strength & power, & to wh God gives his sure & eternal promises of ever inc^r & protec^r, & th she shd b t lbt of his play.

14. But, as Lion h^e been already built, it needed not th labor in t manuf^r, but only to cleanse her, & restore th wh w^e decay^r, & repair t walls wh w^e fallen, & set up her gates th w^e broken, to prep^e her f^r t future w^e of G^d.

15. Ther^r, when th sh be fully effect^e, Lion will

be made ready f^t Law to go forth fr her, to all t inhab^t^{to}
of t wld. For t Wd f^t. Lord sh sound forth, & his Voice
sh res^r fr, know to t ends of t earth. And all nations
sh yet hear th mighty Voice, and tremble bef t light
and power of her heralds.

16. First, as t harb^r of th holy Law & eternal
Wd, t Ld our G^D hath sent forth his angels of prophecy,
under my direction, to inspir^e t chosen chilⁿ of Zion,
to utter & record prophe^c & warn^rg of t nature & manner
of his wks, wh sh take pl in t ord of both his provid^e &
grace throuout all t wld to t end of time.

17. This neces^s, th all t inhab^t^{to} of t earth m learn
his Wd & purposes concern^m all people, to t end of t proba-
tionary st of man. For his Wd, by th prophe^c warning,
sh yet b published to all t race of man.

18. Then sh follow t preach^r of t everlast^r Gospel, & t
Law of G^D, by his chosⁿ witness^s, to every nation, kind^r, tongue,
& people, in all t wld, visible & invisible bef the days
of th Dispens^r sh be ended.

19. For G^D, w pour out upon t inhab^t^{to} of t earth, sp^tl
jud^j, wh w fall upon their souls with a horror of gt
shess, sore convict^r, & fearful terror, far more abf^rl
to them than any outar^r jud^j, until they w esteem it t
g^tst privilege they c poss^r h to find a true witness of

30. G^D, to whom they can confess their sins, and be relieved from these judgments.

20. This oper^w in its times, will thro' t wld in a higher deg, & to a grter extent, than w ever bef kn among men. Then will multit^{ds} flock to Zion. And there sh be no nation on t earth, where habitation of t Roome of the saints of t Most High sh not b estab^d as a refuge to souls.

21. For th cause h t an^t prophets been sent forth, by t will of G^D, first, to bear wit^t of t holy word & wrk of yr heavenly Parents & t holy Angels; and to testify to t truth of all th^r proph^c gifts & Divine revelations.

22. Secondly, to declare to all men, th all th^r an^t prophe^c will h th^r highest & final accomplisht in t wrk of t new & sp^t creation, wh w b completed in th^r gt day of God Almighty.

23. They h ever been t chosen messengers of God, in all ages, ever since they w first called & chosen by t Divine Sp^t, & anoint^d with proph^c oil. And they r now all faithful & beloved chilⁿ of t heavenly Parentage, & faithful messengers of God, in all his wrks.

24. Th holy prophets h revd many things for t etrl Records of t holy S.I. of truth, of wh I read a portion to t proph^t Daniel. These thou hast, in sp^t & subse^c, faithfully written.

25. Ifr I t holy day of Proph^ts do testify th^t the 31
wds, or proph^c testimonies, wh^t they h^t inspired thee to write,
& t six^d oracles of God, concern^t t purp^r & wks of t Alm^t,
to t final estab^t of his eter^t rdom; & none of them sh.
fail of t account^t; but they sh. surely b^t fulfil in t times.

26. But t time is now come f^r t inspi^r messag^es to
cease, & t pres^t season. And t prop^t, f^r a time, & and
will b^t called home to th^t mansions, to prep^e f^r a time
f^r a further wk of God; & then they w^t b^t sent forth to ad-
minister in t prep^rnt wk, & t mighty displays of
Divine power & lbt, wh^t God of all^t is abt to pour upo^t t wo.

27. Yet they w^t w^k together with t chilⁿ of Zion, as
they h^t prom^D, and w^t often visit her, & help them in spt,
whether they kn^t it at t time or not. For t wk wh^t is
begin^r in t wo, w^t in t progress of its times, far exceed^r,
in power, lbt, & glory, as well as in judgm^t, any wk
wh^t hath ever taken pl since man w^t on t earth; yea,
all t hosts of heaven w^t be moved in support of its
operations.

Chap. IV.

The Angel reveals t Wk of his Ministrations, fr t first app'c of Christ to t pres^t time. He declares tt he hath & will continue to watch over Zion.

Harken, O ye chilⁿ of Zion, & I w make known unto you t opera^{ns} of my wk, fr t first shining of t light of t new creaⁿ on earth, to t pres^t time.

2. Know ye, then tt t Div. nat^e of Christ w t true seed of G^d, wh proceed^d & came forth fr t real subs^e of t Alm, conce^d & br^t forth by t Eter Mother, Wisd; & ths in due time manifes^d in a human tab^{le}, in him centred t etern^l lbt sent forth to begin t new creaⁿ. Th is t true lbt wh light^b every one tt cometh into that heavenly wld, t new creation of God.

3. I t holy Ang of Lbt & Prof^t, w with th holy Son of G^d fr his birth, thro all his wk on earth; for I w app't by his Etern^l Father, to b one of tt select band of holy & powful Angels, who ministered to and suppt him thro all his travels & dreadful suff^{ts}, until he finished his earthly wk, accdg to t perf^t will of G^d, & gave up t ghost on t cross.

4. His agoniz^g & terrible death on t cross, drew

a veil of d^ress w^t m^tl crea^m, & made t angels weep,
& heavens resound with sympath^c lamentations. 33

5. He then descended into t prisons of d^ress; & I
desc^c with him, bear^c bef him t etern^c lbt of t Alm^c.
In th dk & gloomy reg^c, he preached his Gosp^l to t spts
who, f th dissob^c on earth, w bound in th prisons. And t
eter^c lbt, fr t lamp of t Alm^c, wh I carried in my hand,
did shine unto them.

6. And, when t merc^c Saviour h done his w^t in these
regions, by day t found^c f t sal^c of souls in t wld of
spts, whby t found^c f t new crea^m w^t Louie; Then
he burst t bands of death, & arose triumpht; & ascend^c
with him bef t thone of t Div^c Majesty in t etern^c heavens;
where he w rec^c by all t heavenly hosts, with such joy
as had never bef flow^d thro t heavens.

7. Then did his Eter^c Parents own & honor all his w^t
wh exceed^d g^t honor, & bless him w^t etern^c bles^s, and
clothe him wh robes of such Div^c glory, as never before
adorned any crea^m being; and then placed him on a thone
of etern^c beauty, at t right hand of his Father.

8. I assist^d t Apo^l w^t lbt of revn, to estab^b t pri-
mitive Ch^y, in wh I dwelt so long as it stood upon t ground
of its first plant. By t desire of t Sav^r, I prep^t t way
for t Gosp^l to b first receed by t Gentiles.

9. For it w^{as} an angel whom I sent th watched over & prep Cornelius, t Gentile f th spec^c pup^{se}, & then direct him to send f Simon Pet. I prep^d th Apos to go at t call of t messenger; & by his pre, Corn w^{as} converted.

10. Some of t learned sons of nature have doubted whe^r it w^t belovd disciple John who rec^d & wrote t book of Rev. But, I t Aug of Pro^c Lbt, do br with^r to all men, th it w^t very disciple "whom Jesus loved," who recd & wrote those sacred oracles.

11. I am t A^r who w^{as} sent by t will of t holy Law, & insp^d th revelations, thro th holy Apos; & they r t fullest prophetic revelations of t w^k of G^d, to the end of time, (when rightly understood) wh^ever been given on earth.

12. By my own spt, & thro t angels of my ord, I contin to dispense prop^c lbt to t faithful, until t falling away was compl^t. I then withdrew to my heavenly mansion.

13. But, thro all t dk reign of antichrist, I watched over t witness^s of truth, & insp^d them with t lbt of revolu, thro t arm of my ord, & strength^d them in t ties of th^r painful suffer^r, by placing bef them prop^c lbt to see t gl^r glory wh^e they w^{ld} obtain thereby.

14. I w^{as} sent by my Eterl Par, to inspire t first says of prop^c lbt into t French prop^c lbt, i.e. with my angels of light, oper^r in all th wk, until t preparⁿ w^{as} completed

for the final and everlasting Gospel to be ushered
into the world.

35

15. By Div app't, I watch'd over yr ever blessed Mother,
fr her birth. I adm'nist^t t first rays of llt to her, in
her early infancy, & insp^r her wth proph^c gifts, & with many
other holy aul's, I guarded & minis^t to her, in t days of her th,
& her growth to matur^t, & gave her proph^c llt to see, in a mea-
sure, her future calling.

16. And after she h^d gone th^t ^{her} severe trials & suffr^g,
in t marr^g st, I again minis^t to her my llt & prophe-
spt, by wh her soul w^t awake to see her situⁿ, & its fu-
ture consequences, if she did not rise out of tt state.

17. By th means, she w^t laid open t seals of convict^m.
She then heard t loud sounds of t trumpets of Reformation,
& of t w^t ft Gosp^t. On hearing these, she hesitated
not, but began her painful travel of redemp^m fr t fallen nature.

18. Thro all t sore trials, & t dreadf^l suffr^g of her travel,
until she rec^t full reviv^r of t everl^g Gosp^t of th day,
I watch'd over, guard, & helped her, & adm'nist^t proph^c llt, by
wh she w^t enabled to see her duty & future calling, in all
things, as fast as t deg of t w^t required it.

19. And I can witness th she w^t truly ffel, & flinched not
at any cross, tribul^m, or suffr^g; but walked in t path of perf^t
holiness. By these means, she obt^d complete redemp^m fr

36 the fallen nature, & rose, by t new birth, thro t Divine
Spt, into t resur^t of eternal life. Then w she receiv'd &
own'd by t Lamb of G^d, as his Bride, & t bles^d M^r of t new cre.

20. And when, by t comm^d of her Lord & Head, she w sent
to th favor land of Colum^b, I cross'd t foaming ocean wh her,
accomp^d by a select band of my an^{ts} of t^t, & many other
holys & powful an^{ts} & sp^{ts}; I guid her thro all those
dang^r scenes, & protec^d her fr t ro^rg storms, & thus silene^d
& flouris^d of those who knew not bt she w t Lord's Servt,
until she reached t shores of th fav^d land.

21. I w wh her thro all her suffr^g, her deep tribul^g, sore
labor, & cruel persec^u, wh she endurd in plant t evnt Gosp^l
in th land; &, with t holy an^{ts}, adm^d help in times of need, and
dispens^d t rays of Div^e & Prophe^c light, by wh she w always
enable to see & kn^w her duty, & foresee t wk of t Gosp^l, to
& end of t prob^r state of man.

22. She perfm^d her wk accdg to t perf^r will of G^d, & when her
severe toils & ardent labors below w fin, in wh she gave up
her life out sp^{ts} cross, int most painfl suffr^g of her chil^d,
then, wh a mult^o of an^{ts}, I assist^d in waft her soul to t etern^t heavens.

23. And I went bef her to t glorious, holy mans^m of J.C. her
Lord, where he recd, hon^d, & bles^d her, for all her labors. Then did
he clothe her w^t a robe of trans^t & etern^t glory; & placed on her head, a
crown of twelve stars of etern^t brill^y. These w^t bright jems of t
twelve heavenly virtues.

24. The glory & bright^s of th' stars did shine forth thro' the
heavens. Then, by t mighty sound trumpts of t Archangels
of t heavens, she w^r proclaimed Queen of t ev'lt^r Kingdom of the
saints of t Most High; & t hosts of heaven bowed, & hon^d her in t cheer.

25. I am one of th' guard^r comp^y of holy an^{ts} who w^r chosen of
G^r to watch o'er Zion, fr her first found^r, thro' all t stages of her
travel. These an^{ts} w^r chosen & app't; thro' t prayers of t holy
Parents of t new creaⁿ. From t diff^t angelic orders, such
w^r selec^t as w^r adapted to adm^r to every st & deg^r of Zion's children.

26. I w^r app'ted, at a sett^r band of t an^{ts} of my ord, to adm^r t
libt^r of review. This Iffully did, to all ranks in Isr, accdg^r to
t times & t deg^r & order of their travel.

27. Yea, in t dlest times th' he overshad^r Zion, I h, thro' t
medium of my an^{ts}, adm^r to t fful a suff^r portion of proph^c
tht to enable them to keep sight of t true ord of Zion, and
to retain a confid^r hope of her restoration.

28. I h ever std by t fful Leaders of Zion, & all her
upr^r chil^r, & w^r my light supported th' trouble sp's; so th^r
they fainto not until t times of reformation came. And I h
been with you thro' all this gr^r & wonderful visitation.

29. I have sent forth, by t will of my Eterl Parents,
my holy an^{ts} of light, to adm^r t proph^c libt^r of inspir^r to t chosen
inst^r of yr heavenly Parents, in all t deg^r of this work.

30. These angels w^r t inned to operat^r, t libt^r of th' lights being

t. medium of convey; & they h given a porⁿ of th llt to every
child of yr heavenly Parents who wd rec^e it; by wh they h been en-
abled to discⁿ t preci nature & eter import^e of those bles^r gifts,
& holy laws & reg^r, wh h been so bountif^y given & besto upon them.

Chap. V. Angels closing Address.

Now hear my wds, all ye chosen chilⁿ; hearkn & give ear, &
let them sink deep into yr hearts; for behold my mes^s of inspi^r
must shortly close. Therf^r, in token, I es an ever^r memorial of
t nature & ord of my wk, I give, with my stay & eter^r blessing,
to each child of t new cre^r a lamp of transh^t silver, filled
with t oil of life & heavenly joy, & burn^r with prophetic light.

2. This lamp, if they keep it well trimmed & burning, by
holly zeal, sh at all times give them llt to see how to walk
in t path of red^e, agreeable to t will of G^D. And, if they kp the
laws & holly ord of hion, th lamp w always b well supplied with
oil, & will never go out.

3. But if, by careless neglect, they suffer th lamp to go out,
they will b in dan^r of eter loss; & they w then b led by t spt
of dks, & walk in t path of disdt, wh leads to final destrucⁿ.

4. Therefore they must surely land in t regions of dks,
unless they turn abt, honestly conf^r their faults in t ad of God,

and, thro humble reperit, ^{ice} wash away t stain, and by ferv^t
zeal agn t^e th lamp, & by its t walk in t path of obedience. 39

5. O holy & d^r chil^m, do, do fr ever kpt th lamp burn
bright, & it w lead you safely to t mansions of et^r glory.

6. And ye holy Ant, belov^d Lead of Isr, whom my sp^t
gthly loves, f yo fful labors in yr holy, try, & heavy
charge. So u give a lamp of trans^t gold, wh w for
ever burn w t lt of Div^e Revlw. This is a general
lamp, f u in yr united capacity.

7. I also give a similar lamp to eⁿ memb^r of the
hol^y anointed in t Mount of G^d, & to t anoint^d Lead of
eⁿ tribe in Isr. By t lt of these ye sh also ^{be} b able
to see & kn t mind & will of G^d, & how to lead all yr people
who w b ^b e, into t perf^t wk, accdg to t ord of t day
of Michael, t holy Archangel of Perfection.

8. And, if th lamp b kept well trimm, & burning, ye shall
alw ^{go} h his help & sure prot^c; for holy Mic, & his aw^{ls} of
perf^t wk, always come a wk, & adm^r t^r powerf strength
wherever they see t lt of this Divine Lamp.

9. The gen^l lamp of t anoint^d Lead, in th Holy Mount of G^d,
is four times as large as t lamp wh I give to t Lead in
any tht branch of Isr^L; bec fr them must go forth t Div^e
lt of revlw, to all t famill^s of Isr^L; to t east, west, north,
& south, until, thro those branched, it sh spr^t to t ends of t earth.

10. To th blos^D of ca ord in Yow, I give a pure crystt lamp, fill wht oil of lt & peace, burning with t fire of love, by wh ye sh alw^o h t revlw of Sw H, to see & kn how to lead all t memb^o of yr respec^{ve} orders (if they w follow) int path of true obediance, in union with t holy Anoint, and in peace and love with each other.

11. All these lamps, holy chil^m, u may each, in yr respc^{ve} orders, transmit to yr chil^m & discres, thru all ger-nerations. And, if ye fully ffil yr wk in time, ye sh, in return, when ye come into eternity, be supplied with lamps of eter^L brightness forever to reuin.

12. Dear chil^m, ye lovely inhab^b of Yow, never bef did t whole body of Gods cov^t people stand in such lt, purity, ord, & beauty, as ye now ds, espec^{ly} in t Holy Mount. And never w there any body of people wh t holy angels of lt, holi^s, & perf^m, loved so well, and with whom they took so much del^t, as they do among u at this time.

13. Kp th state, I entr^t u; kp it forever, & go for in t same bles^d & hly wk, & unspeakably gt sh b yr reward int mansions of eter^L glory. And now I bestow upon u all my ever^l love & eter^L bles^d, & ever to rem^m with ea ffal soul.

14. So farewell; fare ye well, d^r chil^m, in t purrest of love. I go to my D & yr D; but I sh fver watch over Yow; & some of t holy angels of propt^r It w constantly dwell with & min^m

unto u. And fr my ord I w often send my awl, with
many bleſ^{gs} of Div It & holy love; yea, I sh myself ris^t
t child of Lion, when nſful, in every inc^r deg of th^t trou, t bend of time.

15. But hearkn yet again t chil^m, while I decl^e unto
u my closing warn. Prepare, prep^e, for t g^t & marv^{ls}
wk, wh t L^d G^d of all power is beginning in t wld, both nat^l
& sp^l. Know ye, t t pres^t time commences t most
eventful & extre^m period, in t order of providence & grace,
t hath ever taken place in the world.

16. For behold, t Most h^t is risen in t majsty of his power
& glory, & is drawⁿ nr, to vis^t t inhab^t of t wld f th^t iniqu^t, & to
del^t & save all the week & upright among men.

17. Ths^t prep^e to meet yr G^d, all ye people of t earth, if
he w^s powr out t fury of his indign^m upon t wld, bcc of t abomⁱ
of its chil^m, wh, in his times, sh sweep thru all nations
of t earth, like t furious surges of a mighty flood.

18. Yea, bef an^t jubilee^x sh come over ^a lion, t strange,
unaccount, & won^dful things, wh sh take pl in t mat^l
heavens & earth, & t many signs wh sh be seen, w utterly
conf^t all t wis^m of man, & derange all t calcns of mortals.

19. And thus these events sh t way b prep^t, by means wh go
th n^t of, & many thousands of souls to flee to Lion, &
humbly seek prot^c, & w rec^e t Gosp^l of salvation.

20. But I forewarn you, O ye chil^m of Lion, t many days

42 days of sore^w, sore trib^l, in painful suff^{ro}, & dread^{ns} persec^{ns}.
w befall you in t times of evry spen^g of t Gosp^l, until t voice

unto her ffal chil.^m I couf^m tell all t yr heavenly Parents, & t
below Proph^{ts}, & holy an^{ts}, have rev^D on these subjects.

21. Al^rworthless, I leave with u t dñe from ^{sec} Eter^l Powr &
Wisd, th t Alm w overshadow t ffal, with his prote^{ct} wings of
ever strewn^g of love, & w kee them safe as t choice jew^{ls} of his Rdom.

22. Tho^f, whatever u m suff, never for to testify t Gosp^l
in its purity; but stand ye firm & unshaken, & boldly b^{tr}uth^s
to t testimony of yr heavenly Parents, even unto death. Then
all these things sh surely work out ys exceed^g reward; f
Zion sh never fall bef her enim^e, saith t Eter^l Spirit.

23. Tho^f those very means wh t enemy takes to overthrow
her, she sh, at every strug^{le}, b^y t hand of her G^D, more & more
glorif^D & exalted, until she sh b seen & known by all people,
as t first in glory, powr, & dign^{ty}, of all powers on earth; & all
domin^{no} sh serve & obey t Voice of God through her.

24. This is t will & oracle of t Alm^g to u, O ye chosen people
of his love, which shall stand forever.

25. And now, with my last farewell, I give, as a final
present, two classes of etern^l flowers, of most exquisite & never fad^g
beauty, & most delc^h & holy frag^e. The first is of t flowers
of etern^l love; & t sec^d of t flowers of eternal blessing.

26. One of ea of th flowers, my ans w affix to t breast of ea 43
fful child of t heavenly kingdom on earth, f ever to remain. For all
my b^t I dish^{ee} in perf union with t An^t of Divine Love & Blessing.

27. Thus, when such h fin^d th wk in th low vale of sorrow, &
come into eter^t, all sp^ts w kn, by th flowers, tt they h been found
faithful by an^{ts} of light; & they w b accept^d by th^b dear Parents.

28. But rem^t tt these flowers can live only in t pt; they can
never abide d^ress, nor endure t breast of a sinner, nor of any
disorderly & deceitf worker. But to all who contin^e to wlk in
t pt, they sh b immor^t, & sh glorify t poss wth evet^t beauty.

29. And upon thee, thou mort^t just, I bestow my special
thks, holy love, i abid^d bles^d of thy labors in th wk. And, if
thou wilt wlk in t path of humble obed^c, noth sh ever
come upon thee wh sh not wrk f thy good; for my angels
sh watch over & prot^t thee; & same prom^e I give to evry child
in Zion.

30. Yea, I leave with thee a guard^m anl, whose name is
Salvator Regia, who with his bri lamp of prop^t it, shall
guide thee safe thro times, & lead thee to thy heavenly mans^m
in t eter^t cold, where thou shlt meet me in peace. So, in
my peace, fare thee well until we meet again.

31. I now close, by comin^d all these prop^t writings to t
charge of holy An^t on earth, request of them tt they m
all b prop^t record & pres^d, to b used accdg to their wisdom,

44 and the wisdom of the success; if it is design'd by the will of God,
 that they shgs forth, in due time, into all the world, & an everlast^{ing}
 testimony to all generations.

32. Thus have I signed these sacred racks, & sealed
 them with my Divine seal, wh is comp^d of seven most
 brilliant & eternal stars, in the Rainbow of the eternal throne of Jehovah,
 from whence proceeds all prophetic light. These stars are set
 in its seven beauteous & heavenly colors, & glow with ineff-
 able glory, around my name and title, as written in let-
 ters of Divine Light, in the etern^l Records of Heaven.
