March 10th, 1934.

Take 200 lbs of white Hellebore Roots,
put in container and cover with 52 gallons of
85 per cent Alcohol; let stand 16 days in mash.
Draw, press and strain and bottle. Should be
75 per cent when ready to bottle.

Veratrum viride

March 10th 1934

Take 200 Lbs of white Helboar
Roots put in Container + cover with
52 Gallons of 85 per Alcohol
let stand 16 days in Mash
D raw press + Strain + Bottle
Should be 75 per when ready to bottle

Dear Sister Emma:


I am enclosing copy of letter I have written The Proprietary Association. This copy is for you to keep.
