4. I. J. FOX, INC., will keep the goods free from moths, but shall not be held responsible for damages of any kind existing prior to receipt of the goods (the issue of this receipt is not an admission that the articles are in proper condition at the time they are received.)
5. I. J. FOX, INC., shall not be held liable if goods are delivered to any person who presents this receipt, nor for delivery to a person in charge at any place designated by the customer or his or her agent, and such delivery shall be a delivery to such customer.
6. Any error in list of articles, description, limit of liability, rate, or in any other particular must be called to the attention of I. J. FOX, INC., by the customer within ten days after the date of issue of this receipt otherwise this receipt will be deemed correct in all particulars.
7. If I. J. FOX, INC., is unable to furnish cold storage because of government orders or other causes beyond the control of said I. J. FOX, INC., they shall not be responsible for such failure of refrigeration.
8. Notice in writing of any loss or claim for damage must be given to I. J. FOX, INC., within fifteen days after date of shipment of the goods.
