

not be accepted.

5. Remittance must accompany this application, or same will be returned.

 This registration may be secured through the mail. Remit only by money order, certified check or draft. Do not risk sending cash by mail. It is liable to be lost.

7. This card must be signed in the affidavit before a Notary Public or Commissioner of Deeds.

8. First or given name must be signed in full-not initial.

9. Number plates can not be transferred from one car to another.

 If this Renewal Card is mutilated or destroyed, in order to secure a duplicate, it will be necessary to furnish this Bureau with your 1920 REGISTRATION NUMBER.

11. Be sure to answer questions 1 and 2 on other side.



TO FIGURE YOUR REGISTRATION FEE FOR 1922 YOU MUST HAVE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CAR OR YOU CANNOT GET A LICENSE

FIRST - Number of cylinders and bore of cylinders (in order to get correct horse power) SECOND - Year car was manufactured (not necessarily the year you purchased car)

THIRD—Manufacturers list price of your car at time of manufacture, fully equipped (not necessarily the price you paid for it)

ADD FEES FOUND IN TABLES NO. 1 AND NO. 2 AND YOU WILL HAVE THE TOTAL FEE YOU ARE TO PAY

NOTE: At no time shall the annual fee for a six, eight or twelve cylinder car be less than TEN DOLLARS \$10.00), or any other vehicle less than FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00)

If car ic registered on or after July 1, and has never been previously registered in New York State, fee is one-half the annual rate.

Refer to column headed with the year car was made. In this column opposite List Price covering your car, will be found the fee which must be added to fee already found in table No. 1.

TABLE No. 3

FEES FOR OMNIBUSES

Fees for omnibuses for transportation of passengers for hire are fixed according to seating capacity:

5 passengers or less	. \$15.00
Not less than 6 nor more than 7 passengers	. 24.50
Not less than 8 nor more than 10 passengers.	
Not less than 11 nor more than 16 passengers	. 43.00
Not less than 17 nor more than 20 passengers.	52.00
Not less than 21 nor more than 22 passengers.	55.00
Not less than 23 nor more than 26 passengers.	61.50
Not less than 27 nor more than 30 passengers.	67.50

In excess of 30 passengers the fee of \$67.50 and the additional fee of \$2.00 for each passenger (measured by seating capacity) in excess of 30 passengers.

NOTE

The foregoing schedule does not apply to omnibuses operated under a franchise from a municipality over streets designated in franchise wholly within the municipality. The fee for these vehicles shall be \$10.00 without regard to seating capacity.

For an additional fee of \$10.00 an applicant for registration of any omnibus may procure number plates the same as issued for passenger motor vehicles which are not omnibuses.

Every omnibus having a carrying capacity of ten or more passengers must be equipped with a fire extinguisher of a type approved by State Tax Department.

TABLE No. 4 FEES FOR AUTO TRUCKS

Or other motor vehicles for transportation of goods, wares and merchandise are fixed according to combined weight of motor vehicle and carrying capacity:

2 tons or less\$10.00
More than 2 tons, not more than 3 tons 15.00
More than 3 tons, not more than 4 tons 20.00
More than 4 tons, not more than 5 tons 25.00
More than 5 tons, not more than 6 tons 30.00
More than 6 tons, not more than 7 tons 35.00
More than 7 tons, not more than 8 tons 40.00
More than 8 tons, not more than 9 tons 45.00
More than 9 tons, not more than 10 tons 50.00
More than 10 tons, not more than 11 tons 55.00
More than II tons, not more than 12 tons 60.00
More than 12 tons, not more than 13 tons 65.00
More than 13 tons, not more than 14 tons 70.00
In excess of 14 tons the fee of \$70.00 and the additional
fee of \$10.00 for each ton in excess of 14 tons.

NOTE

The law provides that all trucks to be operated on the public highways of the state outside of cities must conform to the following requirements:

Width of body inclusive of load must not exceed 8 ft., except racks for carrying empty barrels, baskets and boxes, hay, straw and unthreshed grain, which must not exceed 8 ft. at base of rack nor 12 ft. at the top.

Height from pavement to top of vehicle or load must not exceed 12 ft. 6 in.

Weight of truck and load combined must not exceed 25,000 lbs., the load to be so distributed that there shall not be more than 800 lbs. per inch in width of tire on any one wheel, width of tire to be determined by measuring width of tire base channel or between flanges of the metal rim.
