
Stephen Munson Sir

After my Respects to you I will inform you
Concerning your Land in this County I have
Searched the Records in this Clerks office & find
it Duly Recorded according to the Original
I have Likewise Searched the Commissioners Books
& could not find it on them, I was therefore obliged
to write to the Auditor at Richmond and have Recd
An answer the purport of which is that the Land
has been taxed since 1802 up to the present Date of
1822 It had been Returned Insolvent & has fell to
the Lottery fund but is Redeemable by paying
the back taxes & Damages in to the Treasury at
Richmond I send you the Letter I Recd from the
Auditor inclosed in this, the Land lies in the
Shorewood Survey the title is good and the Land
will average with the best in the whole Survey
of 140,000 Acres but it Lays Back from the Settlement
about 6 or 7 miles & will not Sell immediately
but is & will be valuable hereafter, If you
Conclude to Redeem the Land I want I should see
the Business for you & will tell you the least
that I can afford to Sell for is 30 or 40 Dollars
it is 210 miles to Richmond & I would be obliged
to go my self & pay the money in to the Treasury
which would take me not less than 14 Days to
be in Expensis for myself and horse, I want you
to answer this as soon as you can & write whether
you want that I should do the Business for you

not if you send money send it in United States
Paper I will answer your Letter as soon as possible
by me & will receipt the money in my Letter if
you send any the amount of Taxes and Damages
on the Land is 14 Dollars 86¢ Cts I have nothing more
to write but wish to be remembered to your
Society Generally particularly at the North house to
Benjamin Brown and family to Mary Brown &
to the Surry people from
