TO THE STOCKHOLDERS OF THE
MILK STREET TRUST.

As an owner of stock in this Trust we feel that you should be advised at this date that your Trustees have not in their possession funds with which to pay a July 1 dividend for the reason that the Metropolitan Trust Company, which leased the first floor and basement in your property, has notified the Trustees that they refuse to accept or be bound by their lease and by this action of the Metropolitan Trust Company the funds, which have been relied upon for payment of this dividend, are not at present available.

Your Trustees have been advised by Counsel that we have a valid and binding lease with the Metropolitan Trust Company and we hope, by appropriate court action, within a short time to secure a decision which will oblige the Metropolitan Trust Company to accept and carry out its contract or to properly reimburse the Trustees in damages sufficient in amount to compensate the stockholders for any present loss occasioned by the refusal of the Trust Company to take possession of the premises,

Further details will be sent you as the litigation with the Metropolitan Trust Company progresses.




