Respected Deacon Richard

We have one request to make to thee (that is this) we will thank thee if thou will be so kind as to send me as soon as it is consistent A power of attorney from Hannah Hetchel well authenticated according to law, to empower me to act for her in all cases and matters in this state such as executing deeds &c. - as her Father John Hetchel at his decease left considerable land property as he was a man that understood the law he left all his business regular and divided the Inheritance by will to the Widow and children - the land has been sold & a deed has to be made before a great while as the youngest air has deceased since Hannah has left these Parts Hannahs Natural Brothers & Sisters are all believers Six in number - they are As promising a family according to pleasant appearance as any they are Among the believers here take them together

Brother Nicolas when I was at the Chh in 1812 you was a making Preparation for drawing wire, and I have never heard wheather it is Carried into effect or how it is doing I want to hear that it is doing well, if thou will be so kind as to inform me some time when it is convenient I will be thankfull
