



When I was received into the Ord Order

Bro. Hiram, a blacksmith who came from
the west, did it for him. He forged & fastened
the iron on the back of the chair, while
another iron, covered with leather was hooked
to the iron on the chair,  in form like
this , straps past in front of ^{his} forehead, to hold
his head steady and to be shaved. I had
to do chores for him, & in his closing days, had
to take a turn sleeping where he could call
on me for assistance, if he needed it, du-
