

Mother Ann's remains & Dr. Wm's were taken
up May, 1835 - small coffins made for the bones
^{11th} & they were reinterred on the 12th in center of
grave yard - The bones were free to inspection
while caskets were being made. On the left side
of Mother's skull was a fracture, said to be made
when she was dragged down stairs, feet fore
most at Petersham. Fracture of $\frac{1}{2}$ in. was
plainly visible above Dr. Wm's left temple.

1815, is recorded a Declaration that our donations public & private have amounted to \$500 a year, which reckoned for 30 years, amounts to 15,000 dollars. Since the establishment of our Society, we have paid the amount of \$2,000 in military fines, in times of peace. When the war commenced, we could not do this without supporting the cause of war, & we refused to pay more for masters or drafts. We got out our Declaration. We have spent in money & labor at 5 shillings a day, over \$2,000, over & above our legal taxation, in building ^{bridges} repairing roads.
