A gold heart hung around my neck with a gold chain on which is written Mother Ann's name peace and good will to all who are faithful to keep the orders of this shop. Given in the new shop in the Elder's room. Father's Class received from Father Joseph an angel of Cure holding in its right hand a burning lamp. & in its left hand a beautiful shining cross. We also received a bitter cup of sorrow & tribulation which we were to drink. March 14. 1841.

March 17. I received some love from Mother Lucy it was pale blue.

March 24. Sat in our evening meeting we received some beautiful presents; A Basket of crosses from Holy Mother Wisdom brought by Mother Lucy.

Also some Peaches & Plums given to us by Mother Ann with her love; a cage of birds from Mother Ann.

After meeting I received some presents from Elder Sister Olive. She said I may want that love comfort & strength. Yea this you shall have I will hand it forth unto thee, I have a gold Treasure and within this treasure is a ball of love, a ball of strength & comfort, also a very beautiful Spinning Cross and said she, bear it up daily. Was we have done and still continue to do, also receive my love & blessing.

July 1853 Mother Lucy placed
a seal upon my forehead.

Sept 22.nd 1848.

Mother Ann poured upon me her
love & blessing and gave me a box of
patience on the cover was the likeness
of Father James with Ann in his
arms. Hannah Fairbanks gave

A Communication or word of notice and Comfort from
Mother Ann to Amy Preed. Monday Evening Sept 25th 1848.

Come unto me my pretty child, for I have come to comfort thee. Dost thou
love thy Mother? Yea. Truly thou dost, and thy Mother loves thee; You are
a sincere child and one that I can love and bless, for you have been
honest to confess & repent, therefore I own thee on earth, and I own thee in
Heaven, so be ye comforted for you have a hard trying place.

I have brought you a little peaceable spirit a peacemaker, will you
receive it; ~~Do not think it a little thing~~ Yea thankfully; Will you at some
suitable time, give out my little peaceable spirit to the Brethren and
Sisters. Yea I will. Will you be free and simple in meeting, and
when you feel a gift or sensation be simple enough to improve in it, and
not be backward because you think you are not chosen as an instru-
ment, ^{to speak my words} you know not who my Instruments are, I have chosen many
and shall choose more. ^{you are my Instruments?} Do you not think I have chosen you Yea you are
one of mine ~~that I have~~ and there are many beautiful gifts of God in
store for you, if you will be faithful. I have a beautiful little man-
sion prepared for you, and when you have finished your work on
the earth you shall come and dwell with me. But you have a great
work yet to do, so be faithful and treasure up the gospel, treasure up
the gifts of God, that you may have wherewith to feed hungry souls as
I have feed you. For many souls will yet flock to Zion, ^{to be clothed & fed} so prepare
^{to make ready} for that day, for it is not far distant.

I have a pretty little gold plate for you, and I will hang it round your neck by the little gold chain attached to it, and the likenesses of your Saviour and Mother are engraven upon it; And when you feel tribulation more than you feel able to bear, look down upon this and it will comfort you.

So now farewell my little one, and I will clothe you with a mantle of my peace love and blessing. Go now and be comforted and prosper in the work of God.

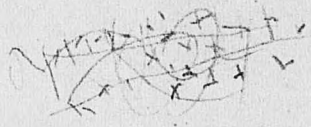

A Cup of encouragement, and a pearl of Holy Love,
wrapped in a sheet of blessing.
A solemn trumpet of praise to sound a loud unto Holy
and Eternal Wisdom
A sheet of paper the gold pen given in singing meeting 1841
