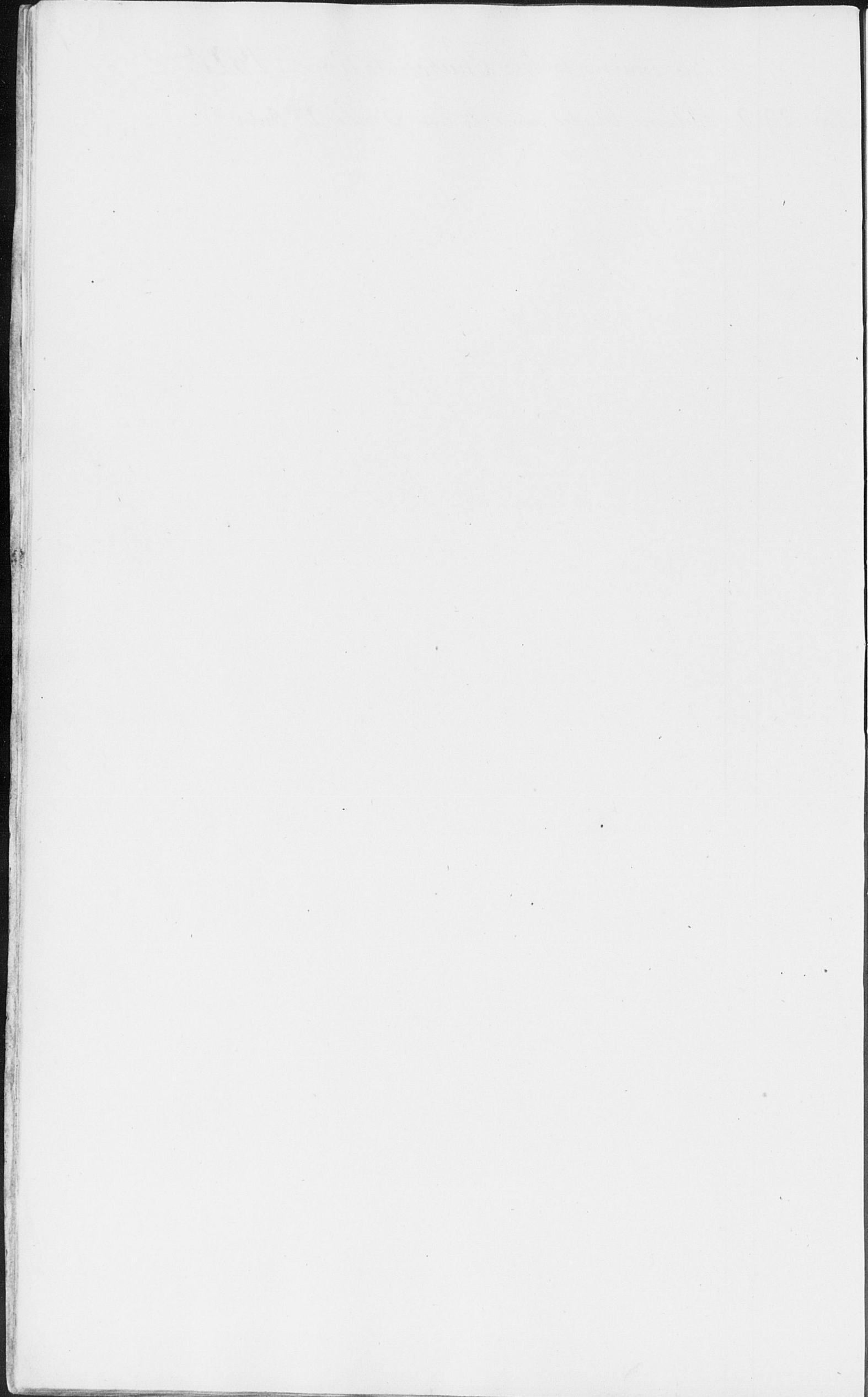

Recipe for making Sacker.

Take 1 ounce of *Aqua fortis*, dissolve in it over a moderate fire
1 drachm of good silver cut into small pieces, this being dissolved
take the vessel from the fire, & throw in as much white tartar
as is required to soak up all the liquor. The remainder is a
paste to silver Copper or Brasse.

A Cure for Blood spavins & wind galls.

Take $\frac{1}{2}$ pint of oil of spike - $\frac{1}{2}$ pint of spirits of turpentine, 1 gill of Venice turpentine - 1 oz. Verdigris - $\frac{1}{2}$ pint of Rum - $\frac{1}{2}$ pint of Curries oil - 1 gill of skunk's grease or the oil of two hogs piggles and 1 gill of goose oil - pound the Verdigris fine and then put the turpentine together with it in a skellet & melt them after this is performed put the whole of the ingredients together and stir them - now bottle it and cork tight and 'tis fit for use - Rub a little on the bunch once a day till it is removed.
