

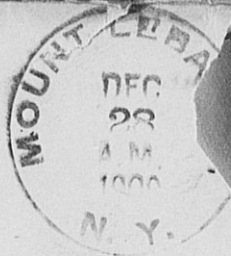

Yours received.
 Also your former letter, which I did
 not answer, as I do not want to
 leave in black & white, just what
 I think, in regard to one & one of
 your stock the past winter, as
 I bought the Bull from good reliable
 parties for my own use, and he
 was doing nicely, when I sent him
 to the farm, and your man & house
 keeper said he was a fine animal,
 and you wrote to that effect, that
 you were very ^{me} glad to get him &c.
 The bull has run with our Cows

day & night in the pasture all last
Summer. also thro' the winter before,
he was let out in the open yard for
water and exercise. Same time as
the Cows were out. &c. I sold my
Old Bull to Elder Daniel Offord,
and he has him yet. and I would have
had the bull I sold you, today, if you
had not asked me to procure one
for you. as I had at that time three
Bulls. the Old one and two Younger.
I concluded to let you have the second
younger. as the youngest was only
a Calf. and I concluded at that time
to keep the Old one, another year &c.

I cannot hold myself responsible
for any animal after it leaves our
farm. especially 6 or 8 months after.
as I sold and also bought the bull in
good faith. I have sold three or four
Cows since I sold to you. and the parties

Were satisfied and pleased.
I enclose a marked copy of the Dairy
Paper that I take, where 61 head of the
Imported Jerseys were sold on May 25
for \$31,330. an average of \$513. — each.
The bull was sold for \$11,000. — and paid
for, and he was taken sick and died
two (2) months later. also see
my other sale of Jerseys where 130
head were sold for \$90,040 — an average
of \$693. — per head. one Cow 12 years
old got \$3,700. — and her 3 year old son —
got \$11,100. — and a daughter 8 months old
got \$1,750. — after these animals
leave the farm, the owners responsible
— etc
