Know all men by these presents that I James Watson of the City of Albany for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred dollars being the principal sum on the within Mortgage & Bond have agreed and by these presents do assign transfer and let over to Henry Gates the within Mortgage & Bond accompanying the same and all money due or to grow due thereon and to be by these presents delivered thereto as follows in the sum of seven hundred dollars on the twelfth day of July instant the sum of seven hundred dollars and do also covenant that the said sum is fully and perfectly delivered on the within premises and that the same will be fully paid and that is, the meantime the defendant will be punctually paid yearly, yearly giving and guaranteeing to the said Henry Gates full and ample power to collect the same by suit in my name necessary or by foreclosure as he may deem necessary and expedient but for his own benefit and behalf and on payment thereof to give such receipts and satisfaction thereof as he shall think proper to cancel the sum of Seven hundred dollars my hand and seal the 1st day of July 1840

heirs, executors or administrators, shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid
unto the above named Jonathan & Edward their
executors, administrators or assigns, the just and full sum of Two Hundred
dollars - in manner & form following, viz. Fifty dollars
upon the delivery of one certain Deed, from Jonathan Wood
& Edward Fowler, to Moses D. Campbell - and the balance
of One Hundred and fifty dollars & interest, on the first
day of July 1849-
