Purchased jointly with the Church  
320 acres Pine timber land \$1.975

NW 1858  
Purchased 80 acres heavy timber land near  
St Joseph and adjoining land owned by the  
Church - said land contains large quantities  
of Black walnut, White wood &c.

Deed given to G. F. & B. E.

March 1859

350 acres good land heavily timber  
lying in the town of Berrien, Berrien Co  
Abyiah Estes owns it.

Dec 4<sup>th</sup> 1871

Sold piece of land in Michigan.

May 1872

Sell 80 acres of Wood lot.

Oct 1872 Michigan Farms surveyed

Mar 1873 Sold Michigan Farms  
receiving in exchange 2 horses and lots  
in Niles Michigan and 4 horses and lots  
in Chicago.

1877

June Trade with J. M. Gray  
who bought the Michigan farm  
160<sup>ac</sup> for 165 ft land in Chicago

1880

Sell Dr Jones in trade 160 acre of  
Pennell farm Mich

Dr Jones 49 acres in Michigan

1885

Sell 111 acre of land in Michigan

1885

July Sell 307 acres land in Michigan  
Shepherd (Gray)

All the Michigan land sold
