Know all men by these presents, that I, Frederick W. Evans, of the Town of New Lebanon, Columbia County, State of New York, in consideration of the sum of one dollar, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for other good and valuable Considerations, do hereby sell, assign transfer and completely set over unto Benjamin Gates and Robert Valentine as Trustees of the Society of Shakers in the Village of Mount Lebanon, Town, County and State as aforesaid all and singular, the real-estate mortgages, mortgage bonds, notes, cheques, money, funds and securities of every description now held by me in my name and deposited or in the care and custody of E. S. Francis, Cashier of the Pittsfield National Bank of the City of Pittsfield, County of Berkshire and State of Massachusetts, or elsewhere — also all payments on account of principal or interest on such ^{real-estate} mortgages, or other securities now due, overdue or which shall hereafter become due, I hereby assign and

transfer to said Benjamin Gates and Robert Valentine, and I hereby expressly authorizing them to collect such due or past due payments or sums of money.

This assignment is executed by me in full and absolute acknowledgment that all funds and securities of whatsoever description standing or deposited in my name are in fact the property of the branch of said Society of Shakers of Mount Lebanon, known as the "North Family" and though held in my name personally were only so held for convenience in administering the duties and trusts of my office as an Elder of said North Family. And the property and powers hereby granted assigned and conveyed by me to said Benjamin Gates and Robert Valentine, as trustees aforesaid is also expressly intended and designed as a conveyance and authorization to their successors, administrators, or assigns in said office, and for

the use benefit and behoof of said
Society.
