Therefore I further agree and promise that so long as I am permitted to enjoy the benefits and privileges of said Society I will faithfully conform to the rules thereof, and will not find fault with the said rules, requirements, regulations, worship nor teachings, by acting or speaking against the same so as to create dissatisfaction, disunion, or inharmony in the family; provided this shall not be so construed as to prevent a free and respectful inquiry of the leading authority into the reasons of said rules and regulations; and if I shall fail to comply with this agreement such failure shall be deemed sufficient cause for loss of membership with said Society, and upon being desired so to do by the leading authority of the family in which I reside, will peaceably withdraw from the same.
