The past year has been a very busy one for all. The new barn was finished, and the grounds around it graded and put in good shape. In their red coats and white trim, the two barns and silo made a very good appearance. The cattle were settled in their new quarters. Full to overflowing with hay, the silo full of ensilage, about six hundred bushels of buckwheat, & fifteen hundred bu. of oats, plenty of roots, potatoes &c — all this on November 8th at 1.30 P.M. when the fire alarm is heard, and those beautiful Barns are in flames, and in a very short time are a mass of ruins.

The cattle were saved, as they were out in the orchard except a few young heifers, also the teams, away at work were saved.

We were obliged very soon to dispose of the stock having neither food nor shelter, except ten cows and a few heads of young stock reserved for family use. We were paid fifteen thousand dollars insurance.
